Intake Narrative Details:

Reporter called to report the neighbor's pit bull got away from their house, and attacked the reporter's dog yesterday. The reporter stated concerns about the neighbor's small child, Braydon, because he's often outside playing by himself, with no supervision, and if that dog gets out again, it could attack the child. There's a pond on the property, and an old rusty trampoline in the side yard. There's an up-turned wheel barrow next to the trampoline. The reporter has seen Braydon climb up on the wheel barrow to jump on the trampoline, without supervision.

About a week ago the reporter was driving by the Villa/Roberts home and saw Braydon at the edge of the pond. There was no adult nearby. The

reporter was afraid he would fall into the pond, so the reporter stopped, drove up the driveway, got Braydon, took him up to the house, and returned him to Mercedes. From what the reporter could see of the house, it looked filthy; not fit for a dog to live in. Reporter also stated that Mercedes was not at all concerned that Braydon had been outside by himself.

The reporter said that Lowell isn't around much, but when he is, there's lots of cars coming and going from the home, all through the day and night. She thinks he's selling drugs.

The porch is cluttered with an old lawnmower and weed eater, several bags of garbage that have holes in them (apparently ripped open by animals). Food containers and food are falling out of the bags. There's lots of flies around the bags. The neighbor also reported that there are several dogs on chains in the back yard. Many of them appear to be pit bulls.

Supervisor met with caseworker to staff the Mercedes Villa case.

Caseworker has made weekly home visits for assessment and to monitor the out of home safety plan. Lowell has been present for one of the home visits, but he refused to talk to the caseworker. Lowell made a statement about needing to get some work done and left the house. On his way out he made the statement "this whole thing's her fault anyway". This is the only communication Lowell has had with the agency. Mercedes says that Lowell does stay with her, but he spends most of his time with his mother. Lowell's truck is impounded and he has lost his job. This is putting substantial financial pressure on the family. Mercedes says she has no idea how they will pay for anything. She states they may try asking her mom. Lowell's mom will help him but not if it means helping Mercedes.

Mercedes has admitted to continued Marijuana use. Mercedes says that she feels guilty after doing it, and she promises it will be her last time. She says that somehow just keeps finding herself in situations where she feels completely defeated and like nothing will get better. Her response in these situations is to "smoke". In addition to this, Lowell brings Marijuana to her and tells her she better use it because he can't stand to be with her when she isn't smoking. Mercedes did not attend her substance abuse assessment, and the caseworker let her use the caseworker's phone to reschedule at the last visit. She stated that she simply could not get the energy to get out of bed. The home conditions have declined again since the home was cleaned. The caseworker observed at least two cooking knives on the floor that Braydon would have access to if he was in the home. When the caseworker brought them to Mercedes attention, she stated "yeah but Braydon's not here right now, and I just don't have the energy to deal with it".

Mercedes recognizes that she needs help overcoming feeling overwhelmed and she continues to express a desire to stop using Marijuana. Mercedes scheduled a mental health assessment immediately following her substance abuse assessment and the caseworker will provide transportation.

Braydon appears happy and healthy living with his grandmother, Helen Villa, who is the responsible party for

the current out of home safety plan. Helen Villa states that it took about a week before Braydon would listen to directives he was given. She believes he was not used to any type of structure or directions. Braydon went to the doctor for a checkup and is in good health. Helen has been asking if she can enroll him in preschool even though Mercedes does not want him to be enrolled. Caseworker continues to remind her that Mercedes maintains custody. Mercedes visits Braydon at Helen's home at least twice a week. Helen was angry that Mercedes missed a visit because she "just didn't feel up to it". Helen stated several times that she has no idea how Mercedes can raise a child if she "just doesn't feel up to it", and she states that Mercedes was raised better than that. Helen continued to by saying that she never needed any state agency's help raising her children, and she did it all by herself. Even though she is angry at Mercedes, she is willing to help drive Mercedes to counseling in the long term. She plans to take her to an appointment to apply for cash and food benefits later in the month.
