### Key Sophos Findings

- Cloud-based mgmt console with limited functionality, does not include role-based administration, DLP, malicious traffic detection, integrated Android security, or mobile web filtering
- No rollback remediation
- Does not run alongside other security products
- Still a traditional antivirus with heavy footprint and high scan times
- Extensive OS coverage on mobile—Android, iOS, Windows, BlackBerry

### Notes and Comments

- Biggest weaknesses are poor on device performance and pretty average efficacy against all types of malware
- SC Magazine notes Management console takes 45 minutes to install
- Offers Endpoint bundle with Mobile
- Gartner Magic Quadrant Leader in Endpoint, Niche or Visionary in Mobile depending on category—MDM or EMM
- Email encryption included
