DRIVER TRAINING Backing Procedures

I. Before Backing

- A) Check/ adjust mirrors
- B) Roll down window/turn off radio
- C) Do a visual sweep of area noting location of potential hazards, including overhead obstructions
- D) Clarify direction signals with round guide

II. Ground Guide

- A) ALWAYS use ground guide if available (your passenger seat should be empty)
- B) Ground guide must maintain eye contact with driver
- C) Hand signals are always from driver's perspective
- D) Ground guide must stay in driver's line of sight
- E) Ground guide must stay out of vehicle path
- F) Ground guide must look in all directions (including UP!)

III. Hand Signals

A variety of hand signals may be used however, the standard signals are as follows:

A) Back:

Wave straight back

B) Stop:

Close fist or Crossed arms

C) Right/Left:

Point arm in desired direction of travel while continuing to wave

vehicle back

D) Straight:

Hold hands apart, palms facing in, at eye level

E) Forward:

With both hands, point forward
