START TIMES & LOCATION

All races start and finish near Oak Park & River Forest High School, 201 N. Scoville, Lake & Scoville, Oak Park, IL.

Races start just east of the High School on Ontario.

5K Run/Walk Start Time: 8am10K Run Start Time: 8:45amYouth Mile Start Time: 9am

5K RUN, 10K RUN & YOUTH MILE ARE TIMED EVENTS

We use the B-Tag timing system, a tag built into your bib. The 5K Walk is not timed, so B-Tags are not on bibs issued to walkers. Please note: if running in both the 5K and 10K, WEAR ONLY THE BIB CORRESPONDING TO THE RACE YOU ARE RUNNING. If you do not do this, your race times will be off. Results and finish placement are based on B-Tag times, not your physical place in the race. Someone can finish after you but still have a faster time!

AWARDS

Award Ceremonies are staggered, and will be held as race results are made available. Awards not picked up at the ceremonies can be picked up at Lively Running at 109 N Oak Park Ave in Oak Park, IL.




PARKING STRUCTURE (USUALLY FULL BY 7AM)
