## **Upcoming TOTAL Mortgage Scorecard Change for Return of Mortgage Insurance Premium Factors**

On Saturday, June 11, 2016, the Federal Housing Administration (FHA) will implement a technical change to its Technology Open To Approved Lenders (TOTAL) Mortgage Scorecard technology. Effective on June 11, the TOTAL Mortgage Scorecard will no longer return either Upfront or Annual Mortgage Insurance Premium (MIP) factors to an Automated Underwriting System (AUS) for subsequent return on the AUS's feedback certificate. Mortgagees should consult Appendix I of the FHA *Single Family Housing Policy Handbook* 4000.1 (SF Handbook) for applicable MIP factors.

AUS vendors have been notified of this change, and are making accommodations to their systems in advance of the change.
