<p>Sam's mother, Mrs. Kelley called this caseworker to express her concern about Tammy Kelley. She explained that Sam had called her very upset while at the doctor waiting on Tammy to be seen for potential cigarette burns. Mrs. Kelley explained that she was unaware that this had been going on, but had been concerned since she had not seen Tammy or Sam since they moved to Ufala. She said that when Cheryl and Sam lived closer, Tammy would often stay the weekend with her while Cheryl and Sam went out. Mrs. Kelley reported that her husband Samuel had passed away a few years prior from an unexpected heart attack and that she lived alone and that if they needed a place for Tammy to stay, Mrs. Kelley would gladly take her in.</p> <p>This worker asked Mrs. Kelley about her relationship with Cheryl. Mrs. Kelley reported the following: "Cheryl and I have had some difficult times. I don't always agree with the way she treats Tammy and my son, Sam, and I often have shared my opinion about this with her. I think that is part of the reason they moved to Ufala. Cheryl felt like I was interfering too much because I would not let Tammy be around the alcohol and parties, and I made sure Tammy had meals and clean clothes."</p> <p>This worker asked Mrs. Kelley about her relationship with Sam. Mrs. Kelley reported the following: "Sam and I used to be close, but when he got hurt and lost his job, he withdrew from me. I think he has trouble with his pain pills and he doesn't want me to know. I realize that I can't control what he does, I just always hope he figures out the best way. I really hate that he is not doing a good job for Tammy. I wish they lived closer so I could help out more with Tammy's care."</p> <p>Mrs. Kelley described that Tammy has a room at her home and that she keeps clothes on hand for Tammy. She indicated that she would like to be considered if it became necessary to place Tammy in foster care.</p>
