

### **Vaccines: Borrowing and Payback**

Used as an accounting tool to track vaccines being switched between VFC and private stock.

## 1. Borrow (should be based on office and State policy)

## This will create a lot with the opposite VFC status.

#### **During a Visit** As Preparation for the Day 1. Double -click on the order to give the vaccine (for 1. Pathway: Activities > Maintain Vaccine example: HepB). Inventory. **2.** You will get this 2. In the Vaccine Inventory window, Click on the pop-up. 3. Highlight the lot to borrow from. **3.** Highlight the lot to 4. Choose the borrow from. number of doses needed to borrow = 4. Leave the Number of Doses in Number of Doses in New Lot. New Lot equal to 1. 5. Click OK \_\_\_\_\_\_. \*We borrowed 1 VFC HepB to create a lot of 1 dose of 1 private HepB. NOTE: This borrowed only 1 dose to administer to this patient. If you wish to create more to be available to future patients, then increase the Number of Doses in the New Lot.

# 2. Payback

#### 1. Office Receives Vaccine Shipment

- 1. Check your payback needs.
- **2.** Pathway: Activities > Maintain Vaccine Inventory.
- **3.** Click on the radio button: **Show only borrowed lots** (select date range from last shipment).
- **4.** Take note of number of vaccines needed to payback.
  - a. We borrowed 1 VFC HepB to create a lot of 1 dose of 1 private HepB, so we have to take 1 private HepB dose and pay it back to VFC.

#### 2. Add in New Lot Received

- \* You must first enter your new lot into your inventory before you can use it to payback a borrow.
- 1. Click on the Active radio button.
- **2.** Enter in the new lot into the Inventory.
- **3.** Be sure to select accurate VFC status.

#### 3. Payback

- **1.** Highlight the lot to payback from (the one just received and entered).
- 2. Click the Borrow or Payback button



- 3. Highlight that lot # again.
- **4.** Choose the number of doses needed to payback = number of doses in New Lot. (In this example, 1.)

#### 4. Update the Payback/Borrow Status

- **1.** Highlight the newly created lot. This will have the same lot # but opposite VFC status as the original.
- 2. Click the ellipsis to edit.
- **3.** In the Payback status field, click the radio button: *item pays back a borrow*.
- 4. Click Save
- **5.** Re-open the **Show only borrowed lots**.
- **6.** Highlight the lot that was paid back.
- 7. Click the ellipsis ellipsis to edit.
- **8.** In the Payback status field, click the radio button: *item was paid back*.
- **9.** Pop-up: would you like to mark as retired? Click Yes if the number of available doses is 0 and no if there are still available doses left.
- 10. Click Save

# THE VERY LAST STEP AND ONE NOT TO BE FORGOTTEN

IS TO PHYSICALLY SWITCH/MOVE THE INVENTORY TO PAY THE BORROW BACK.
