Unannounced home visit to the Parsons residence. Present for this visit were Sherry, Jade, and Jacoby. When this worker arrived Jade and Jacoby were playing with a little cousin. The children were clean and appropriate. The children appear bonded to their mother as evidence by their positive interaction with her during this visit. The children were very energetic willing to speak with this worker. The children report that things are going well in the home. They report that they are not fearful of being in the home and are happy that they don't hear arguing or see their mom getting hit. The children were very positive and appeared happy in the home. It appears as if Sherry is able to provide for the needs of the children. The utilities were in working order and the Sherry reports that she has applied for housing in order to maintain a home for the children. Currently Sherry is not working and is unable to afford their current home. This worker spoke with the Sherry regarding the upcoming court hearing and the objectives on the case plan.

Sherry reported that she has not followed through with any recommended services thus far. This worker asked Sherry if she would be willing to screen today. Sherry reported that she would be positive for marijuana if she screened today. This worker encouraged Sherry to discontinue her drug usage and would screen her at the upcoming hearing. This worker encouraged Sherry to begin services prior to the court hearing. This worker stressed the importance of complying with the court order and the recommendations of the Agency to reduce the identified concerns. Sherry reported that she would comply with the court and this Agency. The family is also working on employment, housing and budgeting with family stability.

A court hearing was held. A Protective Supervision Order was obtained for Jade and Jacoby. Present for the hearing was Sherry, Luke Duke (Jacoby's natural father), the Maternal Grandmother (Ms. Parsons). The court ordered that a second hearing to be held in 30 days due to the Sherry testing positive for marijuana at the hearing. The magistrate informed Sherry that the children would not remain in her care if she was positive again at the next hearing.

<p>Phone call received from Luke Duke reporting that he will not screen for this Agency because it is a violation of his privacy. He reported that Patty Parsons, maternal grandmother also smokes marijuana and if she is not requested to screen then he will not as well. This worker informed the Luke that if he refused to screen and Sherry continues to screen positive, there would be the possibility Jacoby coming into the care of the Agency. Luke reported that he understood this information but would not screen until he spoke with a lawyer.</p> <p>6/18/10 Phone call to Patty Parsons regarding information received by the agency that she uses illegal drugs. This worker asked Patty to complete a tox. screen to rule out the presence of illegal drugs. Patty refused. She informed this worker that she would not be able to take temporary custody of the children due to her work schedule and having custody of her other grandchild.</p> <p>6/25/10 Phone call to Betty Davis, the paternal grandmother of Jade. This worker inquired if Betty Would be willing to take custody of her granddaughter if Sherry would not be able to continue caring for the children in the home. Betty agreed.</p>

<p>Unannounced home visit to the Parsons home. Present for this visit were Sherry, Jade, and Jacoby. When this worker arrived the children were playing outside with their cousin and Sherry was preparing to mow the lawn. The children were clean and appropriate during the visit. Interaction between Sherry and her children were not observed due to the children playing outside. The case plan goals were reviewed and discussed with Sherry. This worker inquired about Sherry's positive screen on 6/24 which was increased from her initial screen on 6/15/10. Sherry denied any additional usage of marijuana and reported that she was unsure how her levels had increased. This worker reminded Sherry of the magistrate's decision regarding her usage. Sherry denied using marijuana since the court hearing. This worker informed Sherry if her levels continued to increase the children would be in jeopardy of being removed from her home. This worker also informed Sherry that her mother, Patty, and Jacoby's father, Luke would not be considered as placements because they refused to submit to a drug screen.</p> <p>Sherry was screened during this visit and was negative for all substances. This worker inquired of her progress with the case plan goals. Sherry reported that she has not begun to work on any of the identified concerns and expressed her frustration regarding her involvement with this Agency. This worker allowed Sherry to vent but also informed her that this Agency became involved due to domestic violence between her and her husband. The agency approached the court due to her violating the civil protection order. This worker informed Sherry that she would need to begin working on the identified concerns prior to the next court hearing in July. This worker encouraged Sherry to speak with someone in regards to her anger and frustration in order to avoid any further violent situations in</p>	

<p>her home. Sherry was informed that she had been approved for a low-income housing apartment however she would need to call and accept the offer.</p> <p>This worker spoke briefly with the children. Jade and Jacoby report that things are going well in the home. They denied seeing Sherry use or take any drugs. They also denied any additional individuals living in the home. The children report that they spend the majority of their time playing with their cousins at their home. The children expressed concern about being removed from their mother's home. This worker informed the children that the Agency was attempting to work with Sherry to prevent any type of removal. The children expressed genuine love for their mother and reported that they wished to remain in her home.</p>

They reported that Stan spends the night in the home. Stan has marijuana in the home. They report that they have witnessed Sherry smoking but were not aware of the substance she was smoking. The children denied being left alone or with Stan. They reported that when Sherry would leave the home they would go with her or over to Patty Parsons', maternal grandmother, home.

She did report that they were easily consoled and have been well behaved since being in their home. The children are eating and sleeping well. Both children report that things are going well and they are being treated well. They asked how soon they would be able to reunite with their mom. They were crying and expressing their love and concern for their mother. They both reported that they miss her and wish to be back in her home. The children are adjusting the best that they can. They are struggling with the separation from their mom.</p>

He asked appropriate questions regarding The care of his son while in the foster home. He and his son interacted in a positive manner during the visit. Luke will visit on Tuesdays from 4:30-5:30.</p>
