

OP 19 brings OP up to current design standards, increases font size throughout the application, improves the layout of information, and optimizes for touch devices.

This project also involves a significantly new approach to the basic views and navigation within OP:

- Navigation Ribbon is organized by role, so everything you need for the vast majority of your day is in one place with no hunting.
 - This includes the ability to collapse the ribbon to provide more workspace on tablets
- New Navigation panels ensure you never miss incomplete work, regardless of which forms are open. (Badges - make this a more user-centric statement)
- Schedule & Practice Workflow is now decomposed into Schedule, Clinical Inboxes, and Message Center so don't have to choose among as far as which tab is visible. I.e., you can answer messages or review diagnostic tests without losing sight of the schedule.
- The Chart/Register/Account have been combined so patient information is contained in a single place. As a result, you can optionally now have more than one patient chart open at a time.
- Page elements are being unified. Action buttons at the top, filters next, then fields and grids. Exchanging graphics to words on buttons. Lining things up to be easier on the eye.
- Unified font is more legible, and size has been increased from 8 to 10 points. Resizing is a work in progress, with most popular forms done now, and more as the year unfolds.
- All of the controls are natively more touch-friendly for tablets. Optional tabbed interface provides an experience more like a web browser, especially on small devices.
- Enhanced Security Permissions that provide new edit/view capabilities
- Event Chronology (now named Medical Records) and Letters will now populate in the patient chart
