

Texas Support of Military Spouses

- HB 2214 Relating to the issuance of a temporary occupational license to certain military service members, military veterans, and military spouses. (Expedited equivalent license) Signed by the Governor, Effective 1 SEP 2019
- HB 2530 Relating to the development by the Texas Veterans Commission of an online repository of information for use of active duty military members and their families relocating to Texas. Signed by the Governor, Effective 1 SEP 2019
- SB 1200 Relating to the authority of certain military spouses to engage in a business or occupation in this state. (License Equivalency) Signed by the Governor, Effective 1 SEP 2019



SB 1200: Texas Department of Licensing & Regulations (TDLR) Creates Licensing Options for Military Spouses

Depending on their preference, TDLR will offer several options to military spouses relocating to Texas: (All three options are expedited)

• Option 1: Apply for a 3-Year License

Under this option, a qualified military spouse will receive a non-renewable 3-year license to work in Texas, based on their license credentials in another state. *No application fee, no examination.*

• Option 2: Apply for a 3-Year Letter of Authorization

This method will allow military spouses to receive a non-renewable 3-year authorization letter to work in Texas, based on their out-of-state license. TDLR will issue a letter confirming their authority to practice in Texas. *No application fee, no examination.*

• Option 3: Apply for a Standard License Using Reciprocity

If you currently hold an occupational license in another state, we'll help you transfer your license to Texas. We have licensing reciprocity agreements with other states for Air Conditioning and Refrigeration, Auctioneers, Barbering, Cosmetology, Electricians, and Massage Therapy.

The Texas Nursing Board has just adopted license equivalency rules as well.
