# Office of the Missouri Military Advocate

- MO Military Preparedness and Enhancement Commission sets biennial state strategy, focuses on jobs and economic impact
- Military Advocate, appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the MO Senate for 6 year term, implements strategy
  - Liaison with Congressional delegation and staff
  - Establish contacts and build rapport with Pentagon, supporting institutions, bases and agencies
  - Build and keep strong community/regional partnerships, and multi-state cooperation
  - Pursue new initiatives, policies, and funding for state-wide benefit
- Gain national perspective through the Association of Defense Communities (ADC)



# State Strategic Plan

## Vision

To make Missouri the preferred location for national defense investments and jobs, and the destination of choice for Service members and their families, and veterans.

## Mission

Provide leadership in the state's efforts to support military installations, missions and agencies; enable the growth of defense businesses; and create a supportive environment for Service members and their families

## Goals

Goal 1: (Bases) Retain and grow Missouri's military installations and missions, and defense agencies;

Goal 2: (People) Make Missouri the most supportive place in the nation for Service members and their families, and provide opportunities for them to stay or return when their military service ends;

Goal 3: (Businesses) Retain, grow and support the success of Missouri businesses that provide services or products for defense and national security

# Missouri's Military Locations

## Missouri Air National Guard, 139th Air Wing, Rosecrans Memorial Airport

Home of the 139th Airlift Wing of the Missouri Air National Guard, which operates C-130H Hercules aircraft and is globally engaged in continuing operations in support of the US Air Force Air Mobility Command.



## Lake City Army Ammunition Plant (LCAAP)

This Active Component installation, controlled by the US Army Joint Munitions command, is a 4,000 acre facility operated by OrbitalATK.



## Kansas City District, US Army Corps of Engineers

One of 44 district offices that is home to the resident engineer office.



## US Military Entrance Processing Command, Entrance Processing Station, Kansas City (KC-MEPS)

Has enlistment responsibility in KS and most of MO for administering aptitude/Military Entrance testing for military recruits.



## Naval Operations Support Center, Kansas City, Navy Region Mid-West Reserve Component Command

A regional recruiting center for the US Navy.



## US Marine Corps Reserve, 4th Combat Logistics Regiment-Kansas City

Regimental headquarters and Nuclear, Biological and Chemical (NBC) company in support of the 4th Marine Corps Logistics Group.



## Kansas City National Security Campus/National Nuclear Security Administration

Produces 85 percent of the mechanical, electronic, and engineered material components used in the US nuclear weapon arsenal.



## Whiteman AFB

A joint-service base, with Air Force, Army and Navy units. Its host unit is the U.S. Air Force's 509th Bomb Wing (509 BW). Tenant units include the Missouri Air National Guard's 131st Bomb Wing (131 BW), the Air Force Reserve Command's 442nd Fighter Wing (442 FW), the Missouri Army National Guard's 1st Battalion, 135th Aviation Regiment and the U.S. Navy Reserve's Maritime Expeditionary Security Force Unit 114.



## Camp Clark Major Training Center

Currently used as a training site for the Missouri Army National Guard, including the 35ID.



## Springfield Aviation Classification Repair Depot

Provides theater and depot sustainment and maintenance for rotary-wing aircraft, including UH-60 Blackhawk, AH-64 Apache and CH-47 Chinook.



## Camp Crowder Training Center

Training site for Missouri and other National Guard units. Intensively used for pre-deployment training.



## Macon Training Center

Major training site located on about 3,000 acres that provides Missouri National Guard units ranges and training areas for weapons and maneuver training.



## Missouri National Guard Joint Forces Headquarters/ Ike Skelton Training Site

An almost 400 acre major training facility in the state's capital city that provides ranges and other operational areas, a Missouri military history museum, as well as the Joint Forces Headquarters for the National Guard.



## Army Support Training Center

A multi-state Training Center operated by the 88th Regional Support Command, US Army Reserve.



## St. Louis District, US Army

Corps of Engineers  
One of 44 district offices that is home to the resident engineer office.



## Defense Criminal Investigative Service, St. Louis

On behalf of the DOD Inspector General, DCIS combats fraud, waste and abuse by conducting audits and investigations.



## US Department of Defense, Defense Security Service (DSS), St. Louis Field Office

Oversees the protection of U.S. and foreign classified information and technologies in the hands of cleared industry.

## National Personnel Records Center, St. Louis

The center is the repository of millions of military personnel, health, and medical records of discharged and deceased veterans of all services.

## Defense Contract Management Agency (DCMA), St. Louis Branch

DCMA is the DOD component that works directly with Defense suppliers to help ensure that DoD supplies and services are delivered on time and at projected cost.

## US Military Entrance Processing Command, 11th Battalion, Western Sector Headquarters, St. Louis

The Battalion is responsible for the command and control of the KCMO, Little Rock, Oklahoma City, New Orleans, Shreveport, and STL Military Entrance Processing Stations.

## US Coast Guard Base Det. - St. Louis

Provides general personnel administration, human resource support, medical administration, supply & procurement support, industrial services, Work-Life services and housing support.



## National Geospatial- Intelligence Agency (NGA) Campus-West

NGA operates two facilities in the St. Louis area (city of St. Louis and Jefferson County) that contribute to NGA's mission of being the primary source of GEOINT for DOD and the U.S. Intelligence Community. The NGA, a DOD combat support agency, provides exploitation and analysis of imagery and geospatial information that describes, assesses and visually depicts physical features and geographically referenced activities on the Earth.



## Ft. Leonard Wood

Home of the US Army Maneuver Support Center of Excellence (MSCoE), the Army Military Police School, the Army Engineer School, the Army CBRN School, the Army Prime Power School, the Army Reserve 102nd Training Division, the Missouri Army National Guard's 35th EN Brigade, and large US Marine Corps, Air Force, Navy and Coast Guard detachments. MSCoE provides Basic Combat Training for the US Army, and trains and educates Service members, and develops doctrine and capabilities for the US Army Training and Doctrine Command.



## Wappello Training Center

The facility is a major training site for the Missouri Army National Guard, providing facilities for tactical training, academic training, and logistical support.
