POWER FOR DISASTER RESPONSE

- Rugged MPS units able to be deployed safely. Heavy-duty, water submersible to 4', work tools can be attached for clearing debris
- Multiple MPS units can be tethered together to scale power to need
- All sites that are diesel gen-set enabled can “plug and play” MPS units.



MOBILE OFF-GRID POWER SOURCE

- Up to 600 kWh of battery storage
- Optional 50 kWh hydrogen fuel cell
- Optional Multi-Fuel 60 kWh Genset
- Vehicle-to-Grid compatibility
- Mobile, off grid power source

Location	Daily kWh Needs	Days/Hours of Operation w/ one MPS (500 kWh)	Notes
Cell Phone Tower	40.73 kWh	12 days	
Gas Station	649 kWh	18.5 hours	Operation can be substantially extended if electricity is only for pumps
Water Pumping Station	943 kWh	12.7 hours	
Police Stations, Gyn, Civic Center, Urgent	Case-by-case [1 MW]	[1 day]	Operation can be extended by limit to emergency services and needs
Full-sized Grocery Store	5,500 kWh	[2.18 hours]	Operation substantially extended by limiting electricity use to refrigeration & emergency lighting
Hospital	26,566 kWh	[30 minutes]	Operation extended by limiting electricity use to vital services
