

An integral aspect of the 2025 SAME Strategic Plan is to lead collaboration. SAME has cultivated Strategic Partnerships with over 20 organizations
























SAME: Making an Impact

Support to STEM, Veterans and Our Communities

Last year, SAME's 100+ Posts & members...

- Spent over 16,000 hours supporting <u>STEM</u>.
- Contributed over 10,000 hours of <u>community</u> <u>service</u>.
- Awarded 800 *scholarships*, totaling \$1.2 million.
- Donated nearly \$495,000 to *K-12 STEM* programs.
- Gave nearly \$128,000 to <u>Veterans & disabled</u> <u>veterans</u> programs.
- Spent 5,000 volunteer hours providing support to veterans







SAME Camps Program

SAME, in collaboration with the Army, Navy, Air Force, Air Force Academy, and Marine Corps, <u>hosts week-long STEM camps</u> for high school students who excel in math, science and technology courses and are interested in pursuing engineering, architecture, or related fields in college.

Over 2,000 alumni and 35% have become engineers.
