# What is "Medical Decision Making (MDM)"

- "Medical Decision Making Medical decision making includes establishing diagnoses, assessing the status of a condition, and/or selecting a management option." (AMA definition)
- Medical decision making in the office and other outpatient services code set is defined by three elements (problems, data, risk).
- To qualify for a particular level of medical decision making, two of the three elements for that level of medical decision making must be met or exceeded.
- MDM is the cognitive process required to manage the patient's problems at the time of the encounter that you are billing for.



### 2/3 Elements Must Be Met or Exceeded

### Level 1 Visits: 99211

- There IS no level 1 visit for a new patient
- The concept of MDM does not apply to code 99211
- 99211 definition: office or other outpatient visit for the evaluation and management of an established patient, that may not require the presence of a physician or other qualified healthcare professional.
- Usually, the presenting problem(s) are minimal
- Example: nurse visit for blood pressure follow-up
- You *cannot* use 99211 E/M services (or any E/M services) for vaccine only visits (even if parents choose to split vaccines). The entire nursing work for vaccine visits is part of the vaccine administration code.

Straightforward	Minimal		Minimal risk of morbidity from additional diagnostic testing or treatment

- Problems: 1 self limited or minor problem
- Data: No or minimal data reviewed
- Risk: minimal risk

#### Examples:

Insect bite, observe only
Contact diaper rash, open to air, avoid wipes

Low	Low		Low risk of morbidity from additional diagnostic testing or treatment

- Problems: 2+ self-limited or minor problems or 1 stable chronic illness or 1 acute uncomplicated illness or injury
- Data: Category 1: Any combination of 2 from the following:
  - Review of prior external note(s) from each unique source
  - Review of the result(s) of each unique test
  - Ordering of each unique test
  - or Category 2: Assessment requiring an independent historian(s)



		DATA REVIEWED OR ANALYZED	RISK OF COMPLICATIONS &/OR MORBIDITY/MORTALITY OF PATIENT MANAGEMENT
Low	Low		Low risk of morbidity from additional diagnostic testing or treatment

• Risk: low risk from additional testing or treatment

#### Examples:

Candidal diaper rash & Neonatal acne: OTC antifungal, observation only

Sprained ankle: RICE, NSAIDs

Anxiety f/u: no meds, doing well, continue counseling

 Problems: 1+ chronic illnesses with exacerbation, progression, or side effects of treatment or 2+ stable chronic illnesses or 1 undiagnosed new problem with uncertain prognosis or 1 acute illness with systemic symptoms or 1 acute complicated injury

Moderate	Moderate		Moderate risk of morbidity from additional diagnostic testing or treatment

#### • Data: 1 out of 3 categories

- Category 1: Any combination of 3 from the following:
  - Review of prior external note(s) from each unique source
  - Review of the result(s) of each unique test
  - Ordering of each unique test
  - Assessment requiring an independent historian(s) OR
- Category 2: Independent interpretation of tests OR
- Category 3: Discussion of management or test interpretation

Moderate	Moderate		Moderate risk of morbidity from additional diagnostic testing or treatment

- Risk Moderate risk w/examples including:
  - Prescription drug management
  - Decision regarding minor surgery with identified patient or procedure risk factors
  - Decision regarding elective major surgery without identified patient or procedure risk factors
  - Diagnosis or treatment significantly limited by social determinants of health

Moderate	Moderate		Moderate risk of morbidity from additional diagnostic testing or treatment

#### Examples:

Asthma w/mild exacerbation, review document from last visit to allergist, review recent ER visit for asthma, independent historian OR no data review but write a prescription for increased inhaled steroid controller and review updated asthma action plan

New onset petechiae, independent historian, order a CBC, PT/PTT (or order nothing but discuss with hematologist)

 Problems: 1+ chronic illnesses with severe exacerbation, progression, or side effects of treatment or 1 acute or chronic illness or injury that poses a threat to life or bodily function

High	High	Extensive	High risk of morbidity from additional diagnostic testing or treatment

- Data: 2 out of 3 categories
  - Category 1: Any combination of 3 from the following:
    - Review of prior external note(s) from each unique source
    - Review of the result(s) of each unique test
    - Ordering of each unique test
    - Assessment requiring an independent historian(s) OR
  - Category 2: Independent interpretation of tests OR
  - Category 3: Discussion of management or test interpretation



		DATA REVIEWED OR ANALYZED	RISK OF COMPLICATIONS &/OR MORBIDITY/MORTALITY OF PATIENT MANAGEMENT
High	High	Extensive	High risk of morbidity from additional diagnostic testing or treatment

- Risk: High with examples including
  - Drug therapy requiring intensive monitoring for toxicity
  - Decision regarding elective major surgery with identified patient or procedure risk factors
  - Decision regarding emergency major surgery
  - Decision regarding hospitalization
  - Decision not to resuscitate or to de-escalate care because of poor prognosis

		DATA REVIEWED OR ANALYZED	RISK OF COMPLICATIONS &/OR MORBIDITY/MORTALITY OF PATIENT MANAGEMENT
High	High		High risk of morbidity from additional diagnostic testing or treatment

#### Examples:

- Pt with severe asthma exacerbation and hypoxia/increased work of breathing in office. Refer for hospital admission
- Pt with chronic depression with verbalized threats of self-harm. Refer for crisis psych eval, hospital placement
- Patient with autism, worsening physical aggression outbursts to caregivers, just started atypical antipsychotics which are monitoring for toxicity w/labs
- Pt with worsening seizures, had one this AM which was prolonged w/color change. Independent historian, review last neurology report, review most recent seizure med levels done by specialist, call neurologist to discuss
