

Do Now Plan — Purpose and Format

Support scholars by creating daily Do Nows that are responsive to daily data and the needs of each class. Teachers are responsible for developing their own Do Nows, which occur daily during the first 5 minutes of class.

Do Nows should be used for the following purposes:

- To activate relevant prior knowledge that will support scholars in the upcoming lab/activity
- To review concepts that scholars struggle with, as evidenced by daily data collected by the teacher
- To allow scholars time to review feedback or complete revisions of previously completed Exit
 Tickets or classwork
- To review homework from the previous lesson
- To solidify new understandings discovered in a previous lesson

Do Nows may take several forms, including but not limited to:

- An introductory discussion question to frame scholar thinking for the upcoming investigation and activate prior knowledge
- A prompt to consider and respond to silently/independently
- A short video to watch with an accompanying question/"thinking job" provided
- A new question that assesses a difficult concept or skill the class previously struggled with
- Returned Exit Tickets with feedback, with directions for processing feedback and making revisions
