Bullfrog	Consumer	Slugs
Red-spotted Newt	Consumer	Slugs
Northern Cardinals	Consumer	Ticks, Butterflies
Gray Foxes	Consumer	Newts, Bullfrogs, Voles
Black Bears	Consumer	White-Tailed Deer
Hawks	Consumer	Cardinals, Bats
White Oak Tree	Producer	It does not eat anything, it makes its own food.
Wild Flowers	Producer	It does not eat anything, it makes its own food.
