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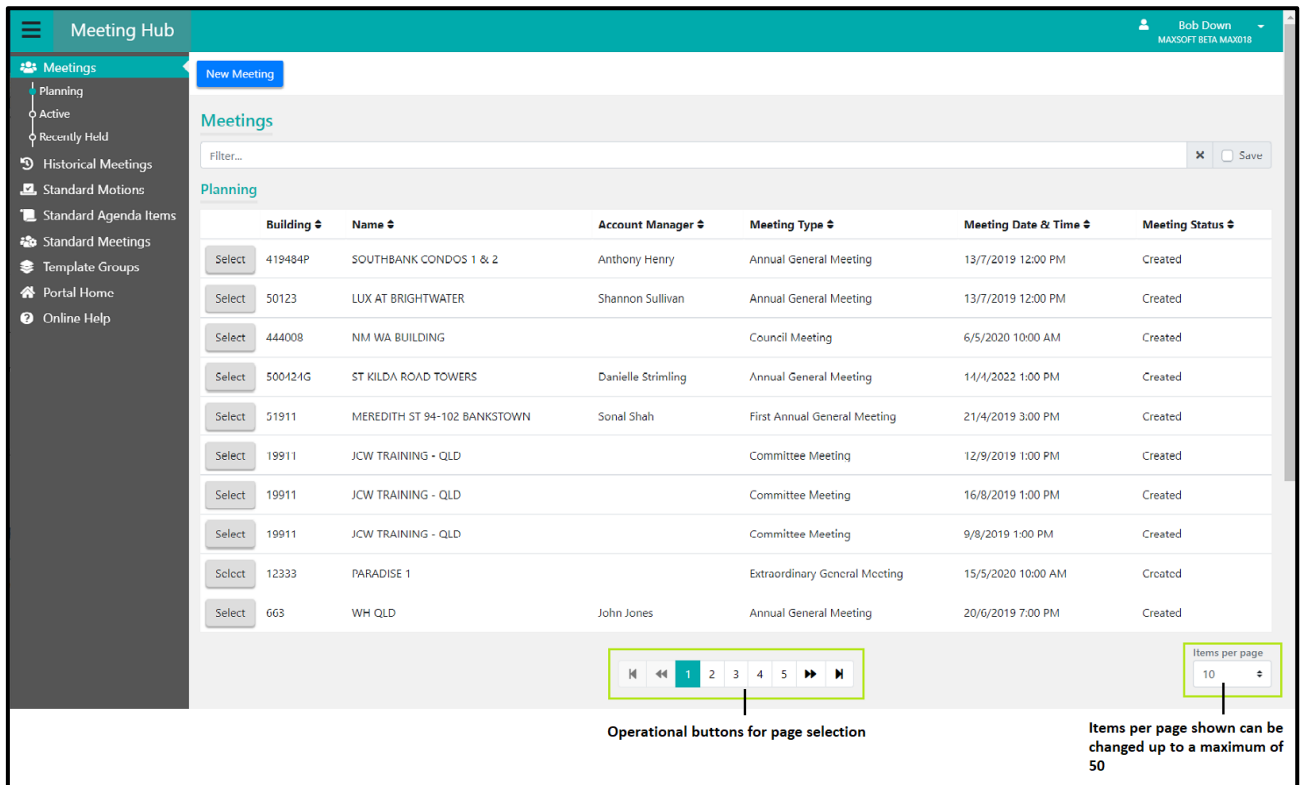
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# What's New

## 1. Meeting Hub - Pagination and Items Per Page added to the Meetings List and Historical Meeting pages




The Meetings List and Historical Meeting pages have been enhanced to include pagination and page filtering improving the performance of the pages.




Pagination options have been included for the Planning, Active and Recently Held sections on the Meeting List page to allow you to move forwards and backwards through the lists. The Historical Meeting pages have one pagination option.

Pagination works the same on both the Meeting List and Historical Meeting pages.


The pagination feature supports the following:

- The current page in a list will be highlighted.
- Progress forward or backwards a single page at a time by clicking the next page number.
- Progress forward 5 pages at a time by pressing the  button.
- Move backwards 5 pages at a time by pressing the  button.
- Progress to the last page in the list by pressing the  button.

- Move to the first page in the list by pressing the  button.

Also included in this release is the ability to select the number of items displayed per list. The items shown per list on the Meeting List page will default to 10, and the Historical Meetings page will default to 25 items per page. The number of items shown can be changed by selecting 5, 10, 25 or 50 from the drop down list. If the number of items per page is changed it will become the new default for the selected list only.

Where there is only one page of results shown for a list which is equal to or lower than the Items per page selected, the pagination buttons will be removed with the items per page field still shown.

The existing meeting filter option at the top of both pages can be used to further define the number of returned meetings shown and update the number of pages shown.

## 2. Meeting Hub – Allow QLD building types SFP, BFP and VP to select Motions with Alternatives for Committee Meetings and Ballots

The Queensland legislation changes that came into effect on 1<sup>st</sup> March 2021 specifically prevents the use of motions with alternatives for general meetings, however this has not been stipulated for committee meetings and ballots.

To allow for this the meeting creation process has been altered to allow motions with alternatives to be selected as a motion type at committee meetings or ballots, for QLD buildings with the buildings type SFP, BFP or VP.

This enhancement allows for:

- The creation of ad-hoc motions with alternatives for committee ballots and committee meetings.
- The selection of standard motions with alternatives when adding standard motions to a committee meeting or ballot.
- The selection of standard motions with alternatives when creating a standard committee meeting or ballot.
- Preventing the selection of a motion with alternatives when adding a motion to a general meeting, or a standard general meeting (AGM, EGM etc).

## What's Better

- URL validation for group of same-issue motions has been enhanced to provide prescriptive error messages.
- Minor issues resolved around creating agenda groups with drag and drop.
- Validation has been added for users with no Meeting Hub permissions set.
- Minor issues resolved for the invalid URL error when navigating away from Meeting Overview and Meeting Detail pages.
- Motion details 'Submission Date' has added validation around the year.
- Attendance Register & Meeting Overview alerts have been improved.
- Minor improvements to Attendance Register around the financial status checkbox no longer appearing for a Body Corporate Manger attendee.
- When removing the eligibility to vote by unticking the eligible vote flag in the attendance register, the user is required to select a reason. The drop-down list will no longer include 'Financial Reasons' as this is no longer valid.
- Minor improvements and validation added to the 'Submitted by Lot Number' field for motions.
- When creating and editing a meeting without a meeting location, the system will no longer attempt to set a default state.
