


1. Excluding voting within Meeting Hub for Proxy voters.

Current Legislation states that where a building state is equal to QLD and a motion's required resolution is set to 'Majority Resolution' then proxy voting should be prevented. In this instance the following is to occur,

The 'No Proxy Voting' flag should be automatically checked on the Motion Details page.



No other states or required resolution types are impacted by this change. Where someone unchecks the 'No Proxy Voting' flag a warning is displayed in the form of an icon prompt advising that 'The required resolution does not support proxy votes.'




The same experience will be valid in the Standard Motions Details page for the state of QLD only and where the required resolution equals 'Majority Resolution'.

For existing motion and standard motions in the system that have a state of QLD and a required resolution equal to Majority Resolution the user will be shown the Information Icon.

2. Offline Voting Register for Motions when No Proxy Voting has been set.

The offline voting register currently uses the legislative rules to determine when a proxy should be able to vote on a motion. While this is partially correct, it does not take into consideration the 'No Proxy Voting' checkbox which a manager may have set on a motion,

A new column "Is Proxy Voting Forbidden" has been added to the motions worksheet which will be used to populate the 'No Proxy Voting' flag from the motion in meeting hub.



Where this is set to 'Yes' against a motion the proxy votes made against the motion will be displayed but no longer be included in the vote count totals on the Offline Voting Registers, Voting Register, Vote Tally and Results spreadsheets.
