Subject: STAPLING OF ENGINE BAFFLES

To ensure that the rubber strips on the top of the rear engine baffles remain in place, it is necessary to staple them in six places. The places are whereever the rubber strips are separated across the top baffle and the two vertical strips on either side are to be stapled to the rear of the horizontal strips, across the cylinder heads.

Before stapling, the strips must be overlapped in such a manner as to allow the rubber to point directly forward at an approximate 90° angle. This will retain the rubber strips in place whenever the top cowling is removed and re-installed.
