Several cases of excessive wear and elongation of eyebolt attachment holes in the rudder horn have been reported to the factory.

In all cases, the subject aircraft have from 500-600 total hours operation at time of discovery of this condition.

All aircraft should be checked at each one hundred hour inspection for excessive wear at this point, minimum allowable edge distance being 3/32". (See attached sketch)

Marginal cases discovered upon inspection may be corrected by adding two rudder arm extensions, part number SK4149. These parts may be procured through the Service Department.
