TO: All Distributors, Dealers, Owners and Operators

SUBJECT: PA-12 and PA-14 Landing Gear Vees

Our Service Bulletin No. 93 dated August 8,1946 and Bulletin No. 97 dated July 10, 1947 recommended reinforcing the landing gear on all of the PA-12 airplanes in the field. Our Service Letter No. 109 dated October 15, 1947 recommended that a streamline tube be installed over the landing gear strap.

It is the consensus of opinion in our Engineering, Sales and Service Departments that the PA-14 landing gear, Part No. 11273-00 and 11273-01 should be used when it becomes necessary to replace the landing gear Part No. 10027-00 and 10027-01 on the PA-12 Super Cruiser.

In the event of damage of one of your gear, either 10027-00 or 10027-01, and you want to install a PA-14 gear, we will furnish to you, at the cost of  $65\phi$ each, Part No. 11317-00 Streamline Tube so that you can rework your good gear as per our Service Letter No. 109. The new and the old gear will then match in appearance.

The PA-14 gear is such an improvement over the old Cruiser gear that we are seriously considering the discontinuation of production on the PA-12 gear. Will you please give this matter your immediate consideration, and advise us as to the pros and cons of the argument.
