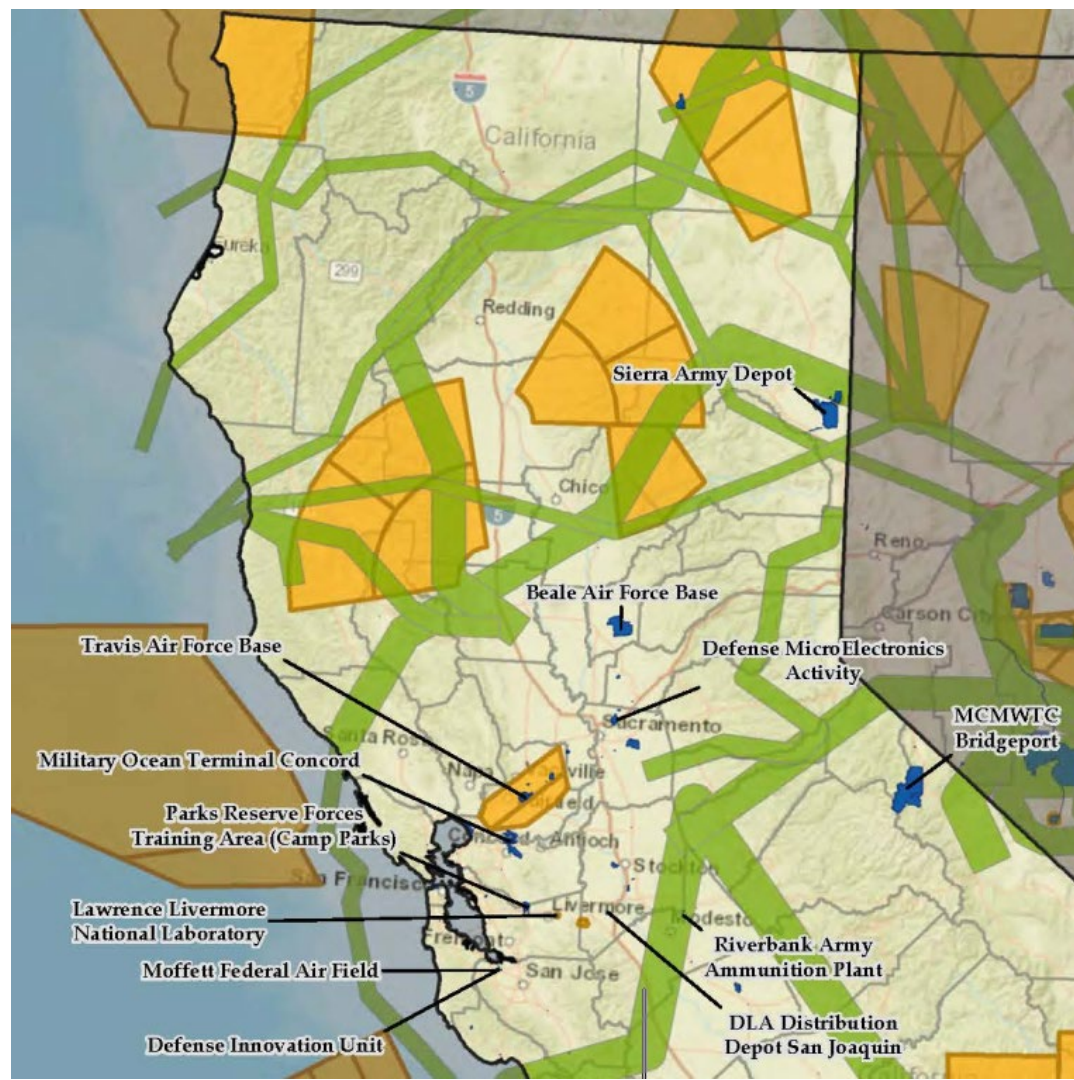


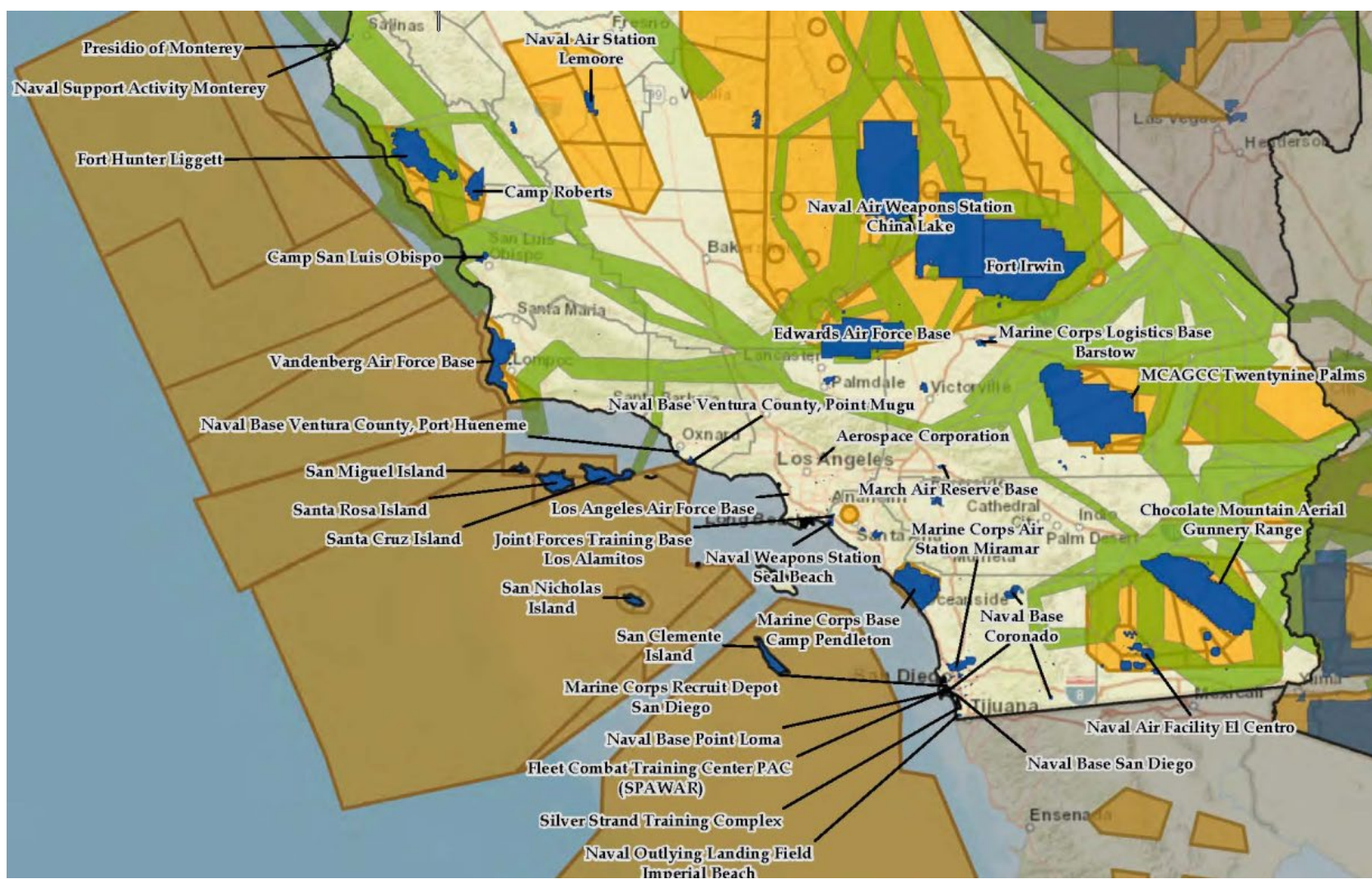

# Why A Statewide Community Support Organization?

---

- ❖ Effectiveness of Any One Community Base Support Organization for Lobbying Is Limited to **Its** Local State and Federal Representatives, Mainly.
- ❖ Provide for Cooperation and Coordination Between Community Groups.
- ❖ Provide for an Organized Forum for Base Support Groups to Join Together & Work Issues.
- ❖ Many Issues Are Common for all Community Groups, And Political Strength Could Be Vastly Improved If All of Communities Coordinated Their Requests to All Representatives.

# State Military Support Organization

---

- ❖ California Established the Governors Military Council A Number of Years ago (March 28, 2013).
  - ❖ Council Agreed On the Need For A State Wide Community Base Group & Encouraged Establishment.
  - ❖ Agreed To Work Closely With Group (If Established) On State Military / Base Support Related Issues.

- ❖ Established With Co-Chairs for Continuity.
- ❖ All Volunteers, No Paid Positions.
- ❖ Original Formation Organizations Are Lead on the Various Responsibilities/Functions.
- ❖ Executive Board (Formation Organizations) Meets by Zoom Monthly To Manage Organization.
- ❖ Minimum of One (In Person) Annual Meeting Planned
- ❖ Annual Dues Assessed To Member Organizations.
  - ❖ All Community Support Organizations Have Seats on Board
- ❖ Expansion of Responsibilities/Function Roles to New Member Organizations as Appropriate Is Planned

# Types of Memberships

---

- ❖ **Community Support Organizations:** California Community based non-profit organizations with the mission of supporting local area military, Department of Defense, and Homeland Defense National organizations.
- ❖ **Local Government Support Organizations:** Local government entity that performs the functions of a community support group when no such local organization exists or is viable.
- ❖ **Associate Members:** Organizations that support military, Department of Defense, Homeland Defense National organizations in the communities that already have a CDCA membership.
- ❖ **Individual Memberships**
  - ❖ **Local City and County Officials:** Appointed or elected city and county officials of communities/counties that have military, Department of Defense, or Homeland Defense National organizations in their area.
  - ❖ **Congressional offices and staffs:** Members of Congressional offices and staffs that represent the above communities.
  - ❖ **Members of Above Organization:** Individual membership is available to those that are members of the above organizations that have an organizational membership in CDCA.
  - ❖ **General Membership:** Individual public membership is available to all who would like to support the mission and purpose of CDCA. This membership is an individual membership and not meant to be a company or organization membership. There are no voting rights connected to this membership.
