

Partners with Huntsville Utilities

U.S. Army Garrison Redstone Arsenal will partner with Huntsville Utilities to provide operations of the *electrical and water* distribution systems and maintenance of the electrical, water and gas distribution systems



#1: Substantial savings on material and equipment costs with Huntsville Utilities' buying power

#2: Employee reach back and augmentation in *emergency or catastrophic*

Partners with City of Rock Island

U.S. Army Garrison Rock Island will partner with City of Rock Island to provide *Water Treatment and Distribution System Operations and Maintenance*, *Waste Water Collection Operations*, and *Waste Water Treatment*, and Exterior Lighting Electrical Maintenance

Partners with Colorado Springs Utilities

U.S. Army Garrison Fort Carson will partner with CSU to *operate, maintain, and repair* the *all gas and electrical systems*

#2: Phase II, expand the IGSA to include all water distribution and waste water collection/treatment systems

Other Utility Partnership Initiatives

Partnerships with Howard County MD, El Paso TX, and Gatesville TX

U.S. Army Garrison Fort Meade will partner with Howard County for **storm water design and engineering** (A/E) and **construction services** and will provide **project management** support for storm water projects



U.S. Army Garrison Fort Hood will partner with City of Gatesville to provide water delivery and management and operation of wastewater treatment systems



U.S. Army Garrison Fort Bliss has partnered with City of El Paso to provide *engineering*, *technical*, *project design*, *minor construction*, *repair and maintenance* incidental to storm water management, water quality, and water conservation.
