

Respondus has been activated for all instructional courses for the next academic year. LockDown Browser is a special browser so students cannot open any other windows. Monitor records students taking the exam and flags significant events, which instructors can watch later.

## Important Considerations

- Once you activate it for a quiz, **it is on for all students or off for all students**. Be prepared to make alternatives available for students who cannot use it because they cannot install it, are using a Chromebook, only have a mobile device, or don't have webcams (if you use monitor).
- **Enable it on a sample quiz with multiple attempts, so they can work out the kinks and practice before the real quiz or exam.** The Help Desk will help students get this working.

## Enable in Canvas

1. Access your course and click the **Settings** button.
2. Click **Navigation** along the top.



3. Scroll to the bottom, click the **three dots** on the *Respondus LockDown Browser*, and click **Enable**.



4. Scroll down and click **Save**.
