Change Grade Scheme

You can add a grading scheme to your course assignments, which allows you to use Canvas to export grades to CampS. Two UW-Eau Claire standard grade scales have been added to the system. If you have a departmental grade scale, email Tiffany Lewis (lewistg@uwec.edu) to have it added to Canvas.

IMPORTANT: You may wish to add the grade scheme **AFTER** you have graded at least one item otherwise students see an F on the grades tab until the first item has been graded.

Canvas uses the following as the default scheme:

1. Click the **Settings** tab of the course in which you would like to add a grade scheme.
2. Select the *Enable course grading scheme* checkbox on the *Course Details* tab and click **set grading scheme**.
3. Click **Select Another Scheme** and select your preferred scale to preview it.
4. Click **Use This Grading Standard**, Click **Done**, and click **Update Course Details**.

Turn Off Grade Distribution Graphs

It's recommended to turn off student view of Grade Distribution Graphs as it is not an inclusive practice. This function is on by default, and it allows students to see the highest, lowest, and mean score for each assignment in their Grades tab. Toggling off this setting for students will not impact your ability as an instructor to see course analytics.

1. Click on the **Settings** tab for your course.
2. Scroll to the bottom of the *Course Details* tab and click **more options**.
3. Select the *Hide grade distribution graphs from students* checkbox.
4. Click the **Update Course Details** button at the bottom of the screen.
