Create a type of local classroom that permits a staff member to monitor student activity in a classroom without impacting any class settings such as Class Tools or Rules.

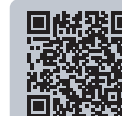

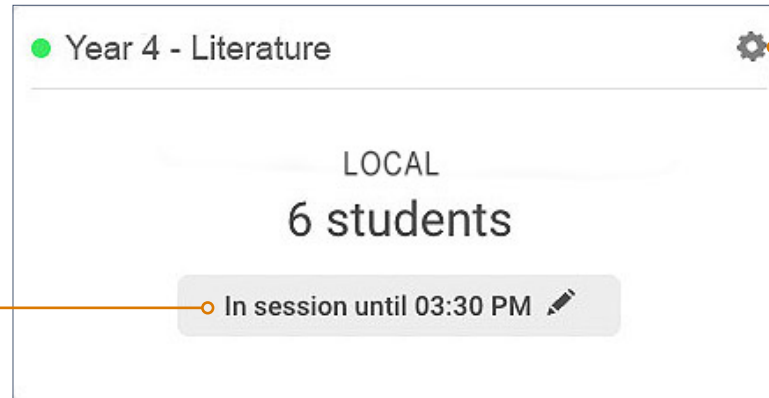

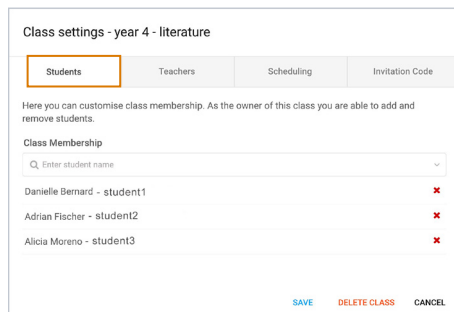
# CLASS SETTINGS

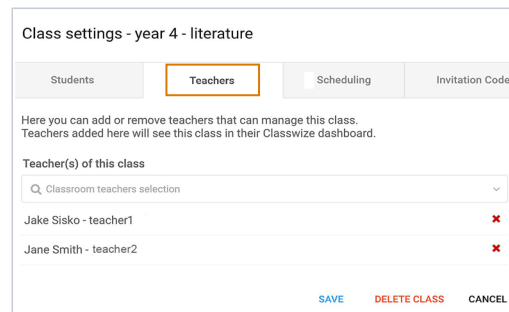

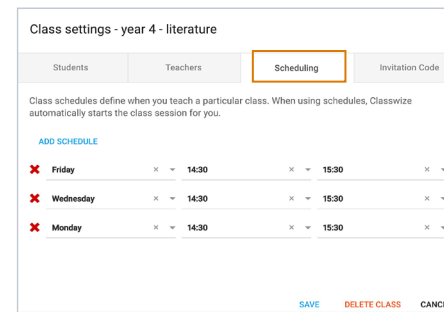

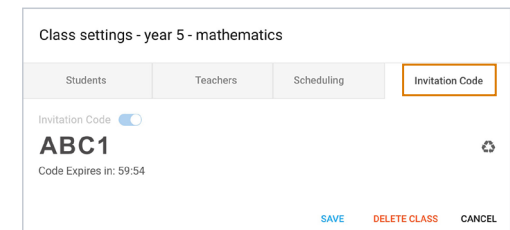

A class that hasn't yet started has the red status indicator. The **START CLASS** button appears next to the class name. Select the button to start the class.

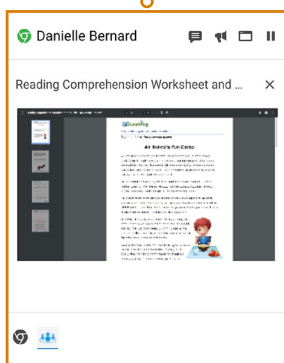


## CLASS TOOLBAR

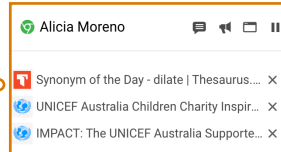

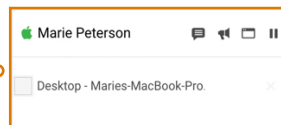
## LIST VIEW

Select **List view** to see a list of the student's currently open browser tabs (Chrome only) and devices (Windows and Mac).

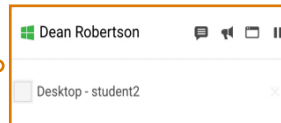

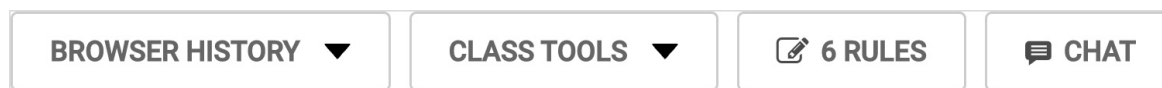

# STUDENT TILE

## STUDENT NAME AND DEVICE TYPE

The tile shows the student's full name and device type. The Chrome, Windows, and Apple logos appear for Chrome/Chromebook, Windows and macOS device types.



## CHAT

Exchange messages with the student.

## SEND A MESSAGE

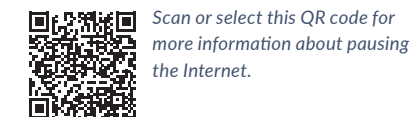
Send a one-way message to the student.

## OPEN SITE

Direct students to a specific resource. They can still close the tab or browse another page afterwards.

## PAUSE INTERNET

Temporarily pause Internet browsing for the student.



## CLOSE

Close the window or tab for the student.

## ACTIVE WINDOW

The title of the current active tab or window on the student's device. To close the active window or tab on the student's device, select the X icon on the right.

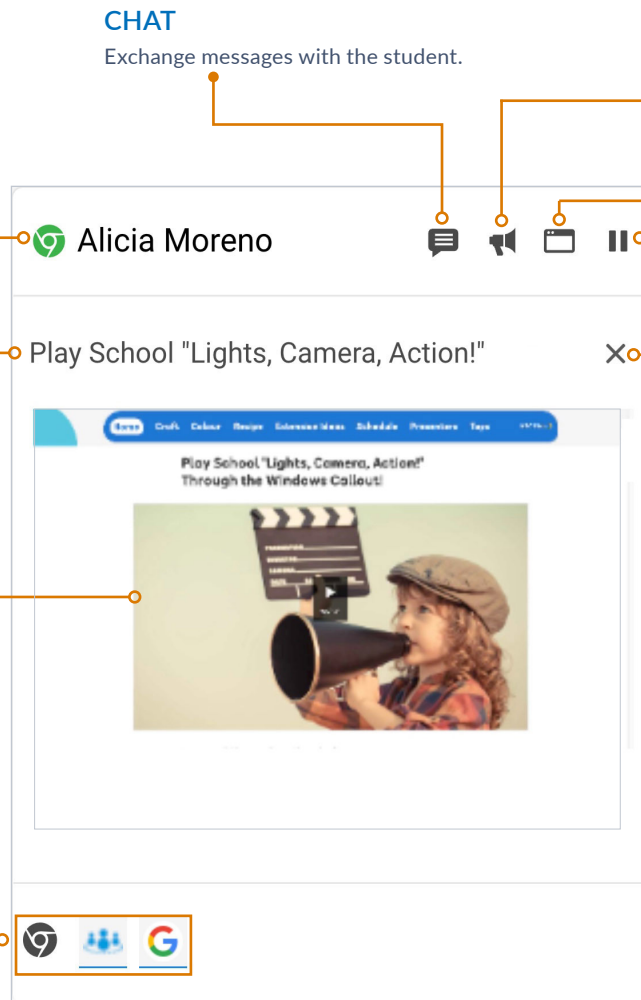
## THUMBNAIL

The thumbnail updates every ten seconds, or whenever the student refreshes their window/tab or browses to another page (chrome), whichever is sooner.

## OPEN TABS

All the tabs that are open on the student's device. Select an icon to view its title, create a rule, or close the tab.

## OPEN SITE

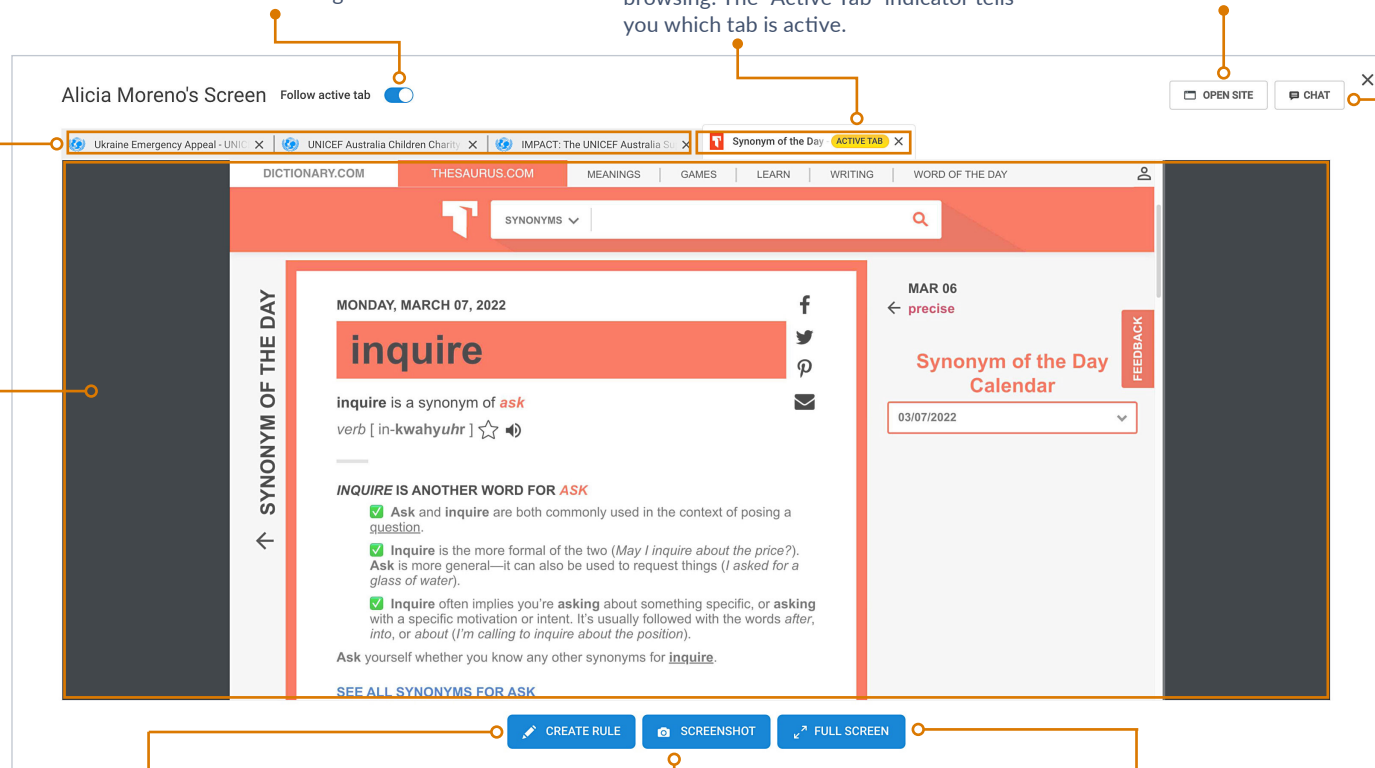

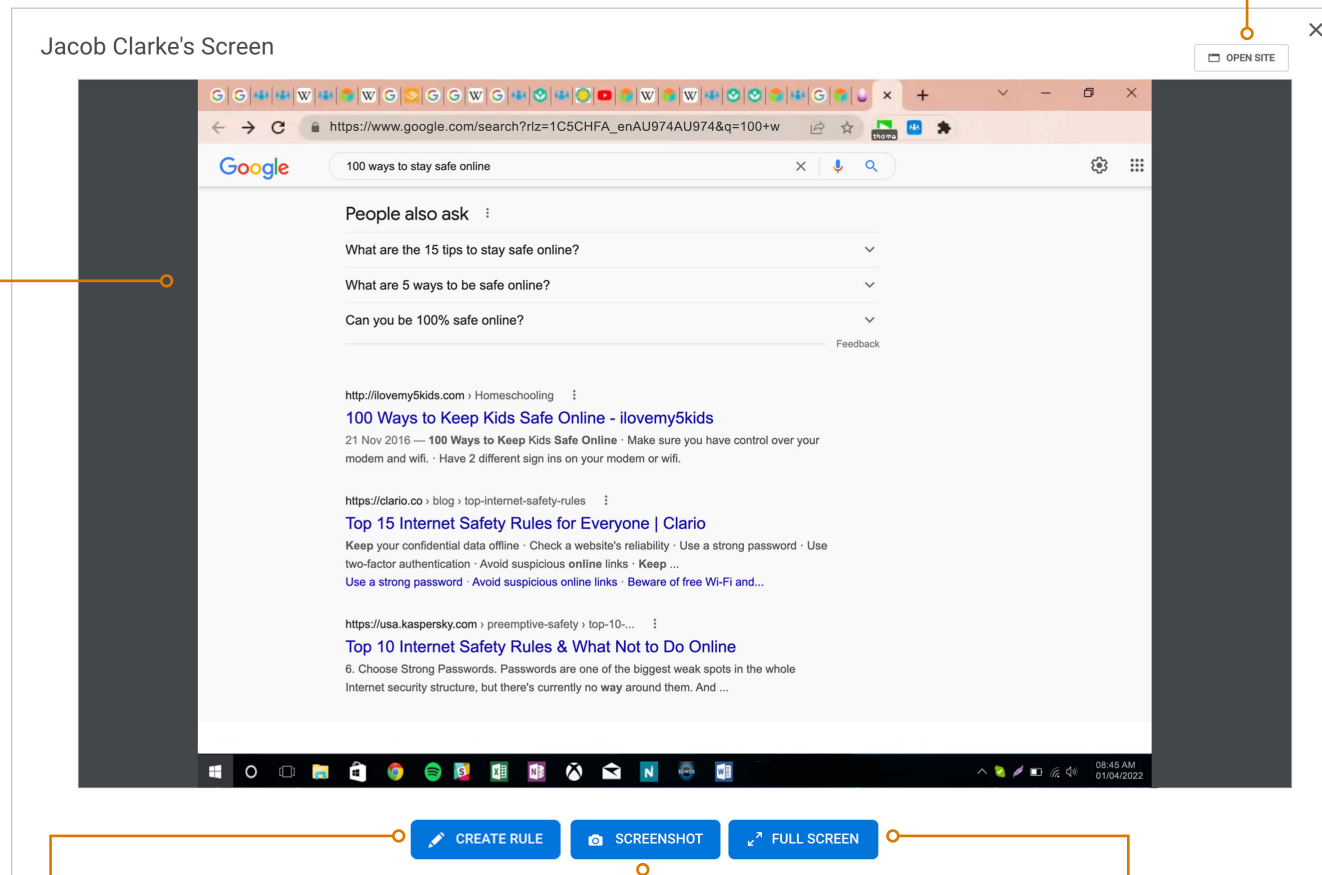

**STUDENT'S NAME**  
The full name and account ID of the student.

**DEVICE NAME**  
The name of the school's School Manager device.

**SITE URL**  
The URL of the site that the student is viewing.

**WINDOW OR TAB CONTENT**  
The content of the site or app that the student is viewing on the Active tab.

**SCREENSHOT DATE & TIME STAMP**  
Date and time the screenshot was taken.

**CLASS NAME**  
The name of the class the class that is currently in session.

**STUDENT'S DEVICE TYPE**  
The type of device used by the student.

**TEACHER**  
Your account ID.

**DATE/TIME STAMP**  
The screenshot shows the date and time that the screenshot was created and downloaded.

**PAGE NUMBER**  
The downloaded screenshot's page number.
