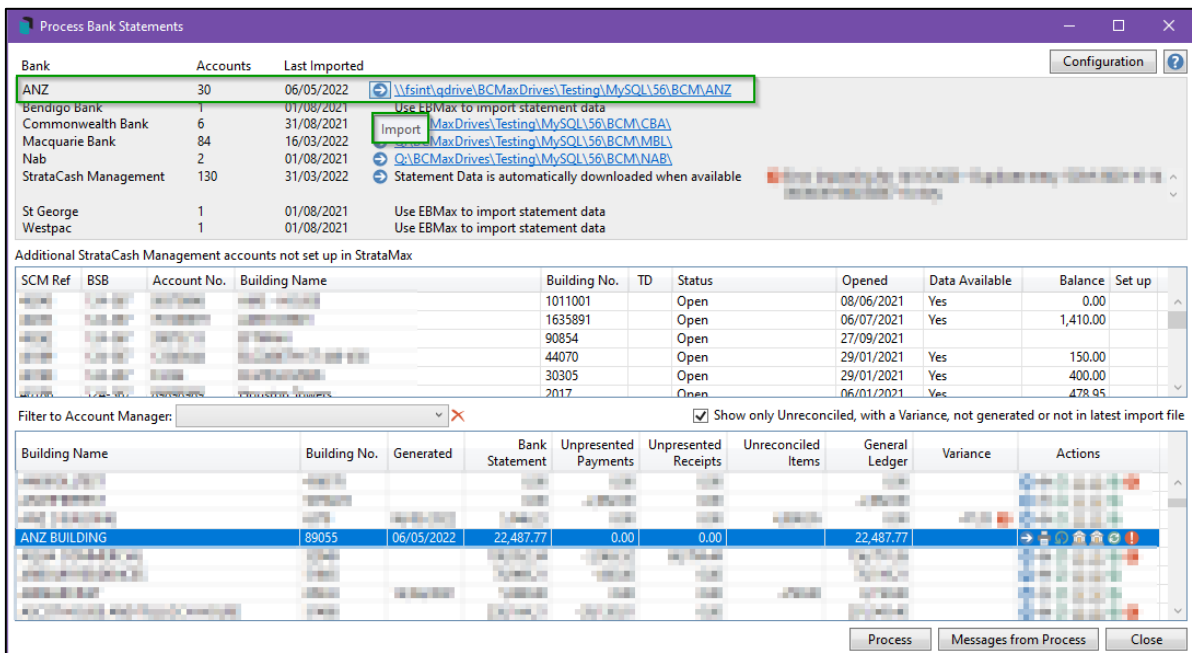

What's New

1. Process Bank Statements – ANZ

Enhancements have been made to import ANZ banking once banking files are downloaded daily using 'Process Bank Statements' icon as shown below:

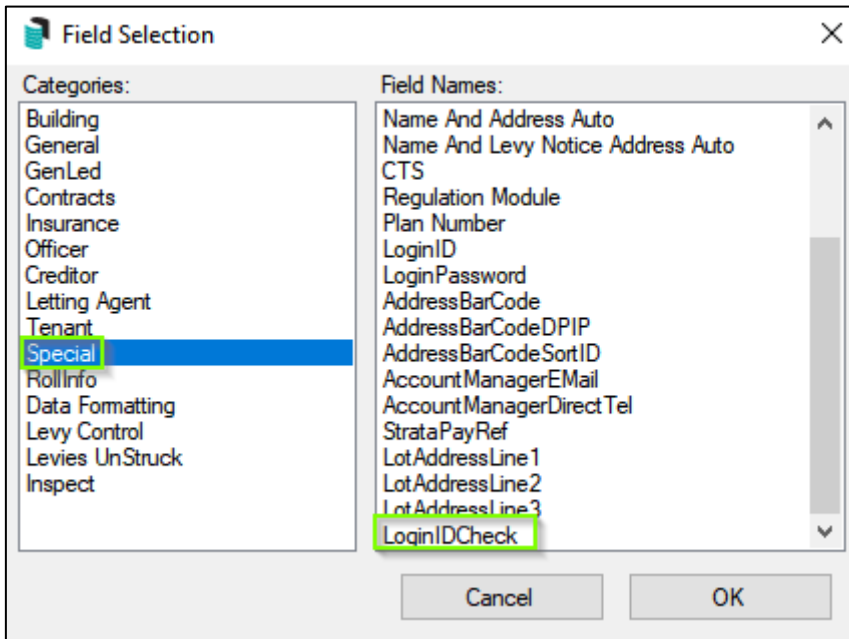
The Process Bank Statements module is designed to give the users a central point to view and action daily banking for all buildings and all banks.



Please Note: All banks except for StrataCash Management, MBL, CBA, NAB and ANZ will need to continue using EBMMax to import statement data before using Process Bank Statements.

2. Merge Letters – LoginIDCheck field

We have exposed the LoginIDCheck field in Merge Letters to provide an option to produce Welcome letters with 9-digit StrataPay Reference numbers. To see this field, navigate to Merge Letters, add fields and click the Special category. The field can also be added to LET letters and is available in Meeting Hub.



If used, the StrataPay Reference will include the 9th check digit.

What's Better

- Enhancements have been made to the Tax Year Report, the grid view was showing Current Year Date rather than the Date of Tax Year selected.
- Legal Action Report – Original Arrears value will output on the report rather than the Current Account Balance
- The old Bank Account Setup form has been removed where there is no bank account setup and payments were accessed. Users will now receive a message that the bank account is not set up and launch the new Bank Account Setup screen.
- New Transaction code has been added for OSKO payments in ANZ bank statements
