A monthly newsletter exclusively for OP RCM Practices **Tip of the Month** Linking Families in OP One of the areas we see our Practices struggle with is the entry of Family Contacts and the linking of patients. **Did you know there are three "families" in OP?**

For revenue purposes, we're most concerned with the linking of Financial family members — which is done by selecting the same Family Contact as the Patient Responsibility Guarantor in the patients' Insurance Records.

This linking makes it possible to send accurate family statements and transfer family credits seamlessly! If you're struggling with this linking, confirm that you don't have a Contact entered into OP multiple times. That's the main reason for the inability to link. If you do, they'll need to be merged. Here's how!

Interperiodic Visits and/or Screenings Medicaid's Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic, and Treatment (EPSDT) programs entitle children under 21 to certain preventive and screening benefits. To this end, all states follow a set periodicity schedule, mostly based on the **Bright Futures** recommendations, to ensure that all ageappropriate services are provided.

If an issue requires diagnosis outside of the periodicity schedule, then an Interperiodic visit or screen would be needed. Billing guidelines for these visits are very similar as the services you are providing are the same, just at different points in the child's periodicity schedule.
