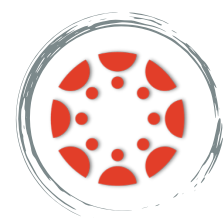


The Tool Possibilities for Group Work at each stage in Canvas



Plan

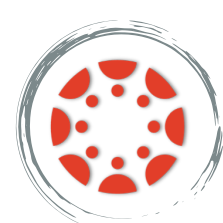
What is the intended activity's outcome?

Canvas People/ Groups

Administer groups:

- Auto-assign
- Manually assign
- Student self-sign up



Canvas Assignments

- Provide the directions
- Student group submissions area
- Assignment grading



Create

Provide assignment guidelines, materials and technologies to promote collaboration and self-learning.



Canvas Pages

Provide the directions, OR let students to be editors of the page for a collaborative space on the course site or in Canvas Group sites.



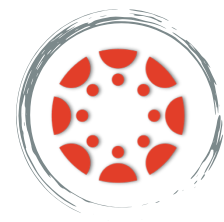
Google Suite (Doc, Jamboard, etc)

An interactive digital document or whiteboard for students to brainstorm and collaborate in real time.



Reflect

Foster a space for students to observe, sort, interpret and create meaning from the collaborative experience and each other's deliverables.



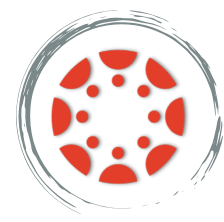

Canvas Discussions

Students post their reflections and comment with observations private to their group or whole class.



Active Class

Structure the progress of the discussion with requirements and nuanced assessment on discussion activity within student groups or whole class.



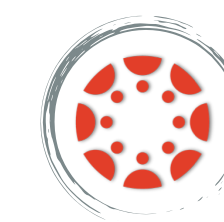
Yellowdig Engage

Open, organic student driven discussion on the groups' deliverables for the whole class.



Grade

Assess a students' work. Provide consistent and constructive feedback so promote clarity and means to improve in future assignments and activities.

Feedback Fruits Peer Review

Students group submit an assignment and review other groups work. Provide students a rubric and structured for constructive feedback.



Feedback Fruits Group Member Evaluations

Students review their team members' contributions to the project and deliverable, OR review other team's presentations. Provide students a rubric and structured for constructive feedback.
