Tip of the Month

Scrubbing Superbills



Marking superbills ready for RCM in a timely manner helps **reduce your AR** and **decreases the time it takes to get paid**. Regardless of who in your Practice is tasked with this, there are a number of things to consider before marking superbills ready:

- Confirm each patient's insurance is valid and entered correctly
- Confirm the correct Copay/Deductible/Coinsurance amount was entered
- Make sure each superbill has the correct:
 - Date of service
 - CPT Code(s)
 - DX Codes associated with the correct CPTs
 - Rendering Provider (who actually saw the patient)
 - Place of Service, Location

2023 Coding Changes

2023 coding updates are approaching! Certain visit categories will be codable based on MDM or Time. Some of these categories include:

- Initial & Subsequent Inpatient or Observation Admissions, and Discharges (same day)
- Office, Inpatient, Observation, and Other Outpatient Consults
- Initial, Subsequent, and Discharge Management for Nursing Facility Services
- New and Established Home or Residence Services
- Only MDM selection can be used for Emergency Dept. codes 99282-99285.
