### **InteliChart Version 3.5.21**



- The Lab Results button is now labeled Labs.



The Patient Portal will now display an action Item and card to alert parents/patients that they have documents to review. The card will include the full patient's name and avatar.




### **Enhancements: Practice Portal**

### **Enhancements: OP Notify**

**Opt-Out Message**Patient Notify > Events >

To add clarity, the default OPT-OUT text message verbiage has been updated to: "MSG&data rates may apply. Reply Stop to opt-out of text alerts."

**Note:** For anyone who Opted-out of receiving text messages, they must text **UNSTOP** to the same phone number the practice used to send these text messages. If the patient/parent is unable to do so, the practice must contact OP support on behalf of their client.
