

What's New

This release of the Online Voting system introduces new and enhanced functionality to Meeting Hub and VoteMax.

1. Meeting Hub – Prevent further capture of votes for nominees elected into executive positions

Votes for nominees of ordinary positions are not required to be collected if the nominee has been elected in an executive position within the same meeting. These nominees will be appear struck out for the ordinary position, with a tool tip advising that they have been selected into an executive position.



2. Meeting Hub – Locking and Withdrawing Motions

In Meeting Hub, the Manage Agenda and Motion Details page has been enhanced for committee meetings, to allow existing motions to be locked into position, and, to allow motions to be withdrawn. These changes ensure functionality on the page is consistent for general and committee meetings.


2.1 Locking Motions

Existing motions in a committee meeting, that is, motions that have been added prior to the meeting progressing to 'Notice Issued' or before the latest notice is

generated, will now be locked to ensure they retain their expected position in the meeting agenda.

New motions that are added after the meeting has progressed to 'Notice Issued' or after the latest notice was generated will continue to be able to be reordered amongst other new motions. These motions can be identified by the <u>_____</u> icon.




2.2 Withdrawing Motions

Existing motions in a committee meeting are able to be withdrawn by selecting the Trashcan icon on the Manage Agenda and Motion Details page when the meeting has a status of 'Notice Issued', 'Reconvened Meeting' or 'Meeting in Progress'.

New motions, that is those that have been added to the committee meeting after it has progressed to 'Notice Issued' or after the latest notice has been generated, are able to be deleted by selecting the Trashcan icon on the Manage Agenda and Motion Details page, if the meeting has a status of 'Notice Issued', 'Reconvened Meeting' or 'Meeting in Progress'.

What's Better

• When creating a meeting in Meeting Hub, the select building screen has been enhanced to no longer allow the State field to be changed for a building.

- When the 'X' option is selected to close out of the Reinstate Nomination prompt screen, the selected nominee will no longer be reinstated and the nomination will remain in a withdrawn state on the nomination list page.
- In Meeting Hub, the Meeting details page has been enhanced to provide a clear error message when an invalid date is entered in the Meeting Date and Time field.
- Committee Nominees are now appearing on the Meeting Details page in Meeting Hub in the order that was selected i.e. Surname or Lot Number.
- Committee Election position calculations in Meeting Hub have been enhanced to allow outcomes for Withdrawn nominations to be stored.
