Resolved Issues

ADT Messaging/Message Center

A new feature has been added for New Jersey Health Information Network (NJHIN) customers for ADT
Messaging. When the Show In Maintain User checkbox is checked in the Main Menu Setup in System Setup
(Supplemental), an option will show in Maintain Users under Admin Tools called the Admit, Discharge, Transfer
(or ADT) Message Center. When all of these permissions are set up the ADT Message Center will show under
Admin Tools on the Main Menu.

The ADT Message center allows for 25 messages per page and allows users to be able to search messages by Patient First name, Last name, Received Date, Sender Facility, type of message. Message types include: Patient Admission, Patient Transfer, Patient Discharge, Patient Registration, Patient Pre-Admission, Patient Information Update, Cancel Patient Admit, Cancel Patient Transfer, and Canceled Patient Discharge. Users will be able to Archive and Unarchive messages

Census Billing

Census billing times can now be entered outside of 5 minute increments.

Client Portal

• If an appointment has already been confirmed the confirm button will no longer show on the client portal for that appointment.

Dispensing

 To improve clarity, the 'Dispensing - Setup Medications' menu option has been moved from the Admin Tools section and will now appear in 'Dispensing Settings' under the Dispensing Module section of the Main Menu.

eMAR

We have optimized eMAR to have a better user experience when maneuvering the module.

Form Setup

• We have updated the form setup page for each row to alternate colors for easier user viewing even as fields are being removed and added. We have also adjusted the color to a light blue color.

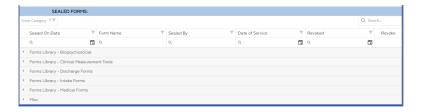

Maintenance Release

Forms

 To increase performance and intuitiveness, the "Sealed Forms" section of Unscheduled Forms has been overhauled. Agencies who use the Form Categories feature will see the new grid grouped by those Form Categories by default. Agencies who do not use the Form Categories feature will see the client's forms in the grid sorted by Sealed Date by default.



Users can drag column headers into the top section to group forms together based on that column. More than one column can be used to group: for example, users can group forms by Form Category, then group forms within that category by Form Name.

Problem List

When discontinuing a problem from the problem list, previous Treatment plans will no longer be impacted.
 Discontinued problems will remain listed on previous treatment plans.

Treatment Plan

• The Previous button on the first page of the Treatment plans has been removed. This will resolve the error that shows when the previous button is clicked on the first page of the treatment plan.
