Professional Services and Mortuary Coding Roll-Out

The next batch of items we are rolling out in our Coding Standardization are **Professional Services** and **Mortuary.**

- Professional Services pertain to standard grooming codes including Nail Trims, Ear Cleanings, and Anal Gland Expressions.
- We no longer have a complicated nail trim. If you have a nail trim that you would have previously charged complicated nail trim.
 You will know use the Technician Appointment (5010-0006) line item + Nail Trim (5000-0003) to cover these charges.
- Mortuary pertains to the euthanasia codes including cremation options and additional items like Paw Prints and Fur Clippings.
 - The Euthanasia line item is already set to change the patient status to Euthanized.

- It's imperative that all plan services are ordered from the patient's wellness plan screen (**not quick invoicing**).
 - O Quick invoicing is **NOT** a reliable way to ensure items are consumed from the plan.
 - Failing to order items from the pet's wellness plan screen leads to inaccurate reporting and incorrect figures around plan utilization.
