






## FY20 Federal R&D Spending By State

Eleven agencies are required to report data for this section of the survey: the Departments of Agriculture, Commerce, Defense (DOD), Energy, Health and Human Services, Homeland Security, the Interior, and Transportation; the Environmental Protection Agency; the National Aeronautics and Space Administration; and the National Science Foundation. Obligations of these 11 agencies represented more than 97% of total federal R&D obligations in FY 2019. Geographic distribution of DOD development funding to industry reflects location of prime contractors and not the numerous subcontractors who perform much of the R&D.

## Partnership: Accelerating Innovation



<u>Goal</u>: To stimulate and support commercialization; and strengthen entrepreneurial ecosystem.

- Piloted in 2018 with 3 Army labs
- Expanded to 5 DoD labs in 2019
- Pre-DefTech
  - Only five PLAs (four active; one inactive) between MD companies and four Navy labs (NAS Pax River, NSWC Indian Head Explosive Ordnance Disposal Technology Division (IHEODTD), NRL, & NSWC Dahlgren Division) in 2016 (FY17 SMTCPP report).
- Post-DefTech (2018-2020)
  - 21 new agreements between labs and MD companies; 17 CRADAS & 4 PLAS. Doubled PLA activity in three years.
- Received national FLC award in 2021
- Re-established in 2023 through Maryland TEDCO for program sustainability

# **Maryland Business Incentives**

### Veterans

•<u>Hire our Veterans Tax Credit</u>: This program provides a state income tax credit to **small businesses** that hire qualified veterans. The credit is based on wages paid to those veteran employees.

 Military Personnel and Veteran-Owned Small **Business Loan Program:** Small businesses that employ or are owned by military reservists, veterans, and National Guard personnel are provided with no-interest loans.

 Maryland State Procurement and Veteran-Owned <u>Small Business</u>: Each state agency in Maryland must structure procurement procedures with the goal of achieving an overall minimum of 1% of the agency's total dollar value of procurement contracts to be indirectly or directly made up of veteran-owned small businesses.

# **Maryland Business Incentives**

### **General Business Incentives**

#### **Biotechnology Investment Incentive Tax Credit**

 Provides an investor with income tax credits equal to 33% or 50% of an eligible investment in a Qualified Maryland Biotechnology Company (QMBC), supporting investment in seed and early-stage biotech companies.

#### Buy Maryland Cybersecurity (BMC) Tax Credit

 Provides an income tax credit of 50% of the purchase price for Maryland companies with 50 or fewer employees that purchase cybersecurity goods, products or services from Qualified Maryland Cybersecurity Sellers (QMCS).

#### **Child Care Capital Support Revolving Loan Fund**

• Provides no-interest loans for capital expenses to childcare providers who participate in the State Department of Education's Child Care Scholarship Program.

#### **Employer Security Clearances Costs (ESCC) Tax Credit**

 Provides income tax credits for expenses related to federal security clearance costs, construction of Sensitive Compartmented Information Facilities (SCIFs) and first-year leasing costs for small businesses doing security-based contract work.

#### **Maryland Manufacturing 4.0**

• Provides grants to small and mid-sized Maryland manufacturers to invest in Industry 4.0-related technologies, machinery and robotics, and digital business practices in order to remain competitive and drive growth.
