Spend time together exploring career research websites such as the <u>Bureau of Labor and Statistics</u>. Here you can research a variety of different career pathways.



Ask to see your mentee's resume. They might need support in identifying their skills and editing their resume. You can help them brainstorm, highlight their abilities, and revise their grammar.
