

What to expect....

Washington State L&I Workers Compensation

GET YOUR EMPLOYEE MEDICAL HELP	 Make sure you have first aid available at your hospital. Ensure employee received appropriate medical attention
WHAT TO EXPECT FROM YOUR EMPLOYEE'S MEDICAL PROVIDER	 The doctor will: Certify whether your employee's injury is work-related. Help your employee file a workers' compensation claim. Work with your employee to decide when they can return to work. Recommend any further treatment they may need.
NEXT STEPS	 Make sure you document how the injury happened. Interview Witnesses and keep written records. When you receive the "Report of Accident" from WA L & I, complete the employer section and either mail or fax when completed.
RETURNING TO WORK	 The employee's medical provider will complete an Activity Prescription Form (APF), noting any restrictions they may have when returning to work or noting that they cannot return. If your employee submits an APF that does not release your employee to work "full duty", they are not authorized to return to work. LAST STEPS	 Stay involved with your employee's claim and only provide information to authorized individuals from L & I. Keep in contact with your employee if they continue to seek medical care for their injury and/or miss work time. This ensures a successful recovery from the work injury and may help them return to work as soon as possible. Please keep HR up to date.
