Essay Requirement

The essay should be a <u>maximum</u> of 2 pages (double-spaced).

Essays should be formatted using complete sentences, paragraph structure, and spell checked for grammar.

Reimbursement Process

- Expense reimbursement is requested through the <u>standard WellHaven reimbursement process and form</u>, which includes:
 - 1. Filling out the standard form when submitting expenses
 - 2. Providing detailed paid receipts/invoices
 - 3. Submitting expenses within 60 days of the expense being incurred (per IRS requirements)
- Must notify their Practice Manager when they submit an expense reimbursement form, so their hospital leadership is aware of the amount being submitted for recordkeeping (award reimbursement is tracked by WellHaven's Finance team and will be charged to campus, not to the winner's hospital).
