🔆 ^{U.S. ARMY} Fort Cavazos- Military Value Program

Goal: To bridge the gap between immediate need (e.g. hotel stay) and long-term need (e.g. 1 year rental lease or home purchase), we implemented the <u>Military</u> <u>Value Program (MVP)</u>.

The MVP:

- Participation is <u>voluntary</u> for Properties and Soldiers.
- Properties apply to participate via Housing Services Office (HSO).
- If HSO approves application, property is listed, and Soldiers are referred by HSO.
- Key Soldier Benefits: fully furnished unit with all utilities including internet; affordable monthly rate; and pet friendly.
- Key Property Benefits: referrals; occupancy; rent on time; HSO support with tenantlandlord disputes.

Results:

- 11 x participating multi-family housing properties.
- Since inception, more than 500 Soldiers and their Families provided affordable short-term housing while awaiting long-term housing.
- Killeen Independent School District (KISD) honoring enrollment at projected long-term housing location while family is in short-term housing location.

U.S. ARMY Solving the Housing Crunch

Upon arrival at an installation, Soldiers and their Families have a **continuum of housing needs**: *immediate, short-term, long-term.*

At Fort Cavazos, we have focused on **<u>partnering with off-post</u> <u>property managers and landlords</u> to bridge between when a Soldier arrives and when their on- or off-post family home is available for move-in.**



Immediate Need (7-14 Days)

- IHG Army Hotels [On-Post]
- Community Hotels [Off-Post]



Short-Term Need (<3 Months)

• Furnished rentals [Off-Post]



Long-Term Need (>3 Months)

- Privatized Family Housing [On-Post]
- Community Housing [Off-Post]



Solving the Housing Crunch

Challenge: "Win the 1st 90 Days" by providing immediate, short-term, and long-term family housing options that control out of pocket costs and minimize family disruption.

✤ Context:

J.S. ARMY

- Single and unaccompanied Soldiers (E5 and below) reside in barracks (~20% of total population).
- Accompanied Soldiers (all grades) and single Soldiers (E6 and above) can choose to reside on-post in privatized family housing (~24% of total population) or off-post in surrounding communities (~56% of total population).
- On average, Soldiers seeking on- or off-post family housing wait 3 months.
 - Soldiers are only <u>authorized between 7-14 days of Temporary Lodging Expense (TLE)</u>. When TLE is no longer authorized, a Soldier must cover their lodging expense with their own resources (e.g. Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH)).
 - For the areas surrounding Fort Cavazos, the <u>average hotel cost is \$98 per night</u>.
 - In 2023, a Sergeant (E5) with dependents receives \$1,287 BAH per month; less than half the \$2,940 cost of staying in a hotel for a month resulting in <u>\$1,653 in out-of-pocket expense per</u> <u>month after TLE runs out</u>.
