Report Code Multi Select has been added to the history search to filter the results by report codes.

Event Code

'Alarm During Delay' has been added to the Event Code setup.

If there is a Delayed Alarm on the account an event with this option selected will end the delay and generate an alarm. When there is not a delayed alarm on the account, the event will be log only.

Open/Close History Report

Open/Close History Reports will return Operator Actions with matching Report Codes.

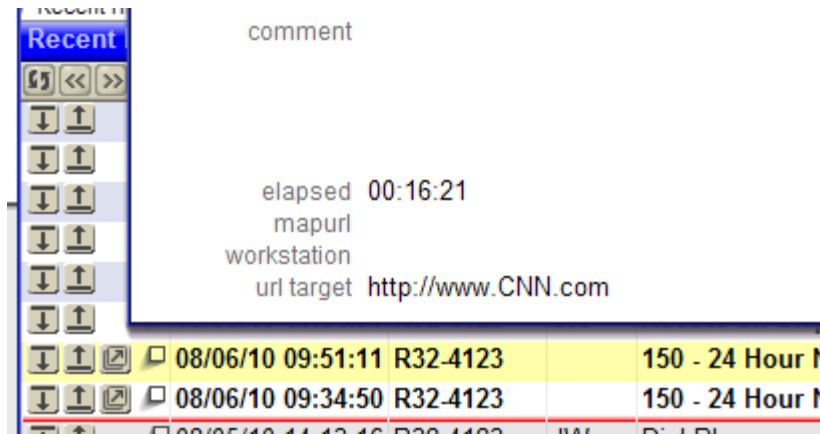
Open/Close History Reports will not return 'No Activity' for Sites by default. This can be turned on for certain Report Types.

Tasks

Added 'No Signal Warning Time' to task set up. If there is no signal received on the task in the time interval entered, the Task will go into error with the '!010 – Task No Signal Warning' event code.

XML Signal Service

Added URL button to history when a URL is received with the alarm. The Button will open the URL in a new tab/window.



** URLs must be sent in with the full address (including 'http://').

Suspended Site Group

A Suspended Site Group list has been added to Utilities | Lists. Double-clicking on a row will open the site group.

Permission for Suspended Site Groups has been added.

File Password

Added File Password field to Report Distribution to secure the PDF file sent in the report.

This can also be applied to the Site Group for all Site Group Reports. The file password on the Report Distribution will override the Site Group file password.

File Password is available on the Email Reports window when PDF file type is selected.

**File Password requires a Report Distribution Service update.

Site Activate

When there are multiple site groups, the hyperlink on 'groups' will open a list of the site groups with a button to open the Site Group Summary. When there is only one site group, the hyperlink will open the summary directly.

Area

The Area and Area Description Variables will search for a recent event with an area when there is not an active alarm.

Incoming Calls

The Incoming Call window, by default, does not automatically open. It is opened from the Site menu (Alt+Ctrl+C). This can be set to open automatically by workstation.

Site Group Callback Number

A field has been added to the site group setup for Site Group Callback Number. This can be used as a Variable in emails/sms.

The stages™ Option 'Auto Dial Callback' has been added to the Dispatch tab. When the option is on, and is supported by Telephony, the outbound calls from the central station to the Site Group's sites will display the Callback Number as the caller ID.
