

# FRONTIER Miles<sup>SM</sup>

## LOYALTY PROGRAM CHANGES

**FRONTIER Miles is Frontier's mileage loyalty program. Members can now earn both Travel Miles and Elite Status Points.**

### Travel Miles

*(previously Frontier/Bonus Miles)*

**These are miles used to redeem for flights or to redeem with Frontier's partners.**

- Travel Miles are eligible for redemption for base fares on Flyfrontier.com.
- Travel Miles do not help a member reach Elite Status.
- Miles do not expire so long as the member generates accrual activity every 12 months; this includes any purchase activity on FRONTIER Airlines World Mastercard.

### Elite Status Points

*(previously Elite Qualifying Miles)*

**These are points used to achieve Elite Status tiers.**

- An Elite Status Point is a point that is solely used to measure a member's progress to Elite Status within a calendar year. A calendar year is defined as between January 1 and December 31 of each year.
- At the beginning of each year a member's Elite Status point balance resets to zero (0) for the purpose of requalification. If a member fails to requalify for Elite Status, they will be returned to "member" as of January 1 of the following year.

## How to Earn

Both Travel Miles and Elite Status Points can be earned by making eligible purchases on Flyfrontier.com, or with your FRONTIER Airlines World Mastercard<sup>®</sup>. Travel Miles can also be purchased at Points.com.

*FRONTIER Miles* members earn 10 Travel Miles and 10 Elite Status Points for every \$1 spent on Flyfrontier.com.

## Mileage/Points Multiplier

If a *FRONTIER Miles* member has achieved *Elite Silver*, *Elite Gold*, *Elite Platinum*, or *Elite Diamond* Status, they will receive a Mileage/Points multiplier. This means that instead of 10 Points, they can earn up to 20 Points for every \$1 spent on the previously listed items.

<b>Member</b>	10x Miles/Points per \$1 spent
<b>Elite Silver</b>	12x Miles/Points per \$1 spent
<b>Elite Gold</b>	14x Miles/Points per \$1 spent
<b>Elite Platinum</b>	16x Miles/Points per \$1 spent
<b>Elite Diamond</b>	20x Miles/Points per \$1 spent



### How does having the FRONTIER Airlines World Mastercard® increase Travel Miles and Elite Status Points earning potential?

With the World Mastercard, you also earn 5x Miles for eligible purchases made on Flyfrontier.com, 3x Miles on eligible restaurant purchases, and 1x Miles on all other purchases. In addition, you'll earn 1 Elite Status Point for every \$1 spent on your card.

## Calculating Travel Miles and Elite Status Points

How many Travel Miles and Elite Status Points do I earn if I am *Elite Silver* Status and I purchase a flight for \$100 on Flyfrontier.com **without using the FRONTIER Airlines World Mastercard®**?

**Travel Miles: 1,200**

**Elite Status Points: 1,200**

Explanation: I earn 10 Miles/Points for every \$1 spent on Flyfrontier.com, but since I have *Elite Silver* Status, I earn 12 Miles/Points for every \$1 spent because of the Mileage/Point multiplier.

$(12 \times \$100 = 1,200 \text{ Miles/Points})$

How many Travel Miles and Elite Status Points do I earn if I am *Elite Silver* Status and I purchase a flight for \$100 on flyfrontier.com **using my FRONTIER Airlines World Mastercard?**

**Travel Miles: 1,700**

**Elite Status Points: 1,300**

Explanation: Since I have *Elite Silver* Status, I earn 12 Miles/Points for every \$1 spent. And because I used my World Mastercard I also earn 5x Travel Miles and 1 Elite Status Point for every \$1 spent.

$((12 \times \$100) + (5 \times \$100)) = 1,700 \text{ Travel Miles}$

$((12 \times \$100) + (1 \times \$100)) = 1,300 \text{ Elite Status Points}$
