




OP Reporting Today



OP supports a variety of reporting methods & tools, so before we jump in to Practice Analytics, let's take a step back and set the stage...







Billing Reports

- Built into OP out of the box, the majority of these reports live under the Billing tab
- These are where the reports that were "lifted and shifted"
- With predefined parameters, these reports cannot easily be modified


Reporting with SQLs

- Accessed via Database Viewer out of the box in OP
- Users can build their own SQL queries

OP Reports (Reports Builder)

- Reports built via Report Builder
- Docs like school and camp forms, General/Referral letters, billing statements, and more can be mass-generated

Why the Change?




- Lacking clarity, purpose, frequency
- Restrictions on the amount of data you can export
- Empowering practices to be more successful (more reports to come)

Under the Hood

- OP → Snowflake → New Reports (data flow)
- Parsed Data
- Nightly Snapshots
- Near-real-time
- Daysheeting and Dates
- No restriction on data (exporting Excel)
- Summarized Data and Visualization
- Updates are not dependent on OP releases







Comparing Current vs. New










Scheduling based reports exclude non-patient notes




Comparing Current vs. New




Charges per Scheduled Appt



Unbilled Charges for Scheduled Appts




A/R Aging Analysis- Summarized Totals



New Reports


Historical A/R



- Snapshots!
- Month over month snapshots of A/R
- Data from March 2024 onward (no retroactive data)
- New data structure/ tables



Patient Demographics



- New Demographic Report
- Capture patient population and key data points
- Easily identify a subset of your patient population
