Summary

This association indicates those students who were involved and not perpetrators for a discipline incident.

Object Triggering

Action	Business Rule(s)
Post	<p>Reports a discipline incident when the incident's Status is marked and saved as "Complete"</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Incident must have at least 1 behavior event associated • Participant has a Role that is mapped to an Ed-Fi Value NOT = 'Perpetrator' • Posting can occur if a new event is added after Incident is marked as "Complete" • Do not send if the student is in a calendar marked as Exclude • Do not send if the student's enrollment is in a school marked as Exclude
Put	N/A
Delete/Post	<p>When the Incident's status is changed</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Delete when the status is changed from Completed to In Progress • Post when the status is changed from In Progress to Completed
Delete	<p>When an event is deleted</p> <p>When student's role is changed from Victim</p> <p>When all non-excluded enrollments in the school and year are deleted</p>
