### Summary

This event entity represents the recording of whether a student is in attendance on a daily basis at their school.

Object Triggering Logic

Note: Georgia only reports Negative Attendance. We do NOT report positive attendance in Georgia.

**Note 2:** Georgia bases attendance off of the Attendance Aggregation Refresh Tool. This tool **MUST BE RUN** before performing a Student School Attendance Events resync.

**Note 3:** Any previously reported attendance records that were deleted from the ODS must have a manual resync of Student School Attendance Events to report those attendance records again. Triggers will **NOT** re-post these records unless attendance has changed on the date being reported.
