- Post longer relief needs without specifying a specific date for example "Relief Doctor needed for maternity leave coverage"

Proactively Search and Message Candidates

- Take advantage of tons of filtering options to help curate and refine your search
- Review candidate profiles (these act as their resumes) to find the best match
- Take matters into your own hands by actively messaging talent
- Utilize the search bar at the top to save all searches and never miss new talent
