Action	Business Rule(s)
Post	<p>When a Grading Period is created and saved in Resource Preferences and a resync is completed.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not report a record if the any of the following exclusions are present: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Calendar Exclude ◦ School Exclude
Delete /Post	A DELETE / POST will be performed if the data element being altered is part of the resource's natural key. A PUT will be performed otherwise.
Put	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This resource does NOT have triggers. A manual resync is required to report and update this resource.

Delete	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• When the Grading Period information in Resource Preferences is deleted and a resync is completed.
