Summary

This association describes the behavior of students involved in a discipline incident.

Object Triggering Logic

Action	Business Rule(s)
Post	<p>Reports a record when a student is associated to an event on a behavior incident that is marked as "Complete" AND has a Role mapped to the Ed-Fi Code <i>O: Offender</i>.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not report a record if the any of the following exclusions are present: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Enrollment State Exclude ◦ Enrollment Grade Exclude from State Reporting ◦ Calendar Exclude ◦ School Exclude • Local event behavior codes must be mapped to a State Event Code in Behavior > Admin > Event Types > State Event Code (Mapping). The State Event Code must be mapped to an Ed-Fi Code in Resource Preferences.

<p>Delete /Post</p> <p>Put</p>	<p>A DELETE / POST will be performed if the data element being altered is part of the resource's natural key.
