

# Kaltura FAQ page customization guide

This guide explains how to customize the FAQ page sections for your organization's needs.

## Changing the banner color

To change the yellow banner at the top of the page:

1. Find the **<style>** section at the top of the HTML file.
2. Locate this CSS block:

```
.faq-header {  
  position: relative;  
  height: 300px;  
  background: #ffd84d;  
  display: flex;  
  justify-content: center;  
  align-items: center;  
  padding: 0 40px;  
  overflow: hidden;  
}
```

3. Replace **background: #ffd84d;** with your desired color code.

## Removing sections

If your organization doesn't use certain Kaltura features (like Events or Webinars), you can remove those sections from the FAQ page.

To find the section you want to remove, look for this structure:

```
<div class="faq-topic faq-topic--red">  
  <h4 class="faq-topic__title">Events</h4>  
  <div class="faq-topic__questions">  
    [questions content]  
  </div>
```

</div>

Delete everything from the opening **<div class="faq-topic">** through its matching closing **</div>** tag.

## Renaming sections

You might want to rename sections to match the terminology used in your organization.

Find the section title:

**<h4 class="faq-topic\_\_title">Events</h4>**

Replace "Events" with your preferred name.

## Changing section colors

You can change the color of any section by modifying its color class. Find the section's opening div tag:

**<div class="faq-topic faq-topic--red">**

Replace the color class (in this example, "**faq-topic--red**") with any of these options:

Blue: faq-topic--blue

Green: faq-topic--green

Orange: faq-topic--orange

Red: faq-topic--red

Turquoise: faq-topic--turkiz

Light Green: faq-topic--lightgreen

Yellow: faq-topic--yellow

Dark Green: faq-topic--darkgreen

Pink: faq-topic--pink

Light Blue: faq-topic--lightblue
