Summary

This educational entity represents an overall score or assessment tied to a course over a period of time (i.e., the grading period). Student grades are usually a compilation of marks and other scores.

Object Triggering Logic

Action	Business Rule(s)
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<p>Post</p>	<p>When a grade is posted to a Grading Task or Rubric that is mapped to an Ed-Fi Grade Type.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Grading Task/Standard must be mapped to a Grading Period to report. • The Grading Task/Standard must be marked as 'State Reported' • Only report final (posted) scores. No 'in-progress' grades report. • Check to see if the student has a Student Section Association in the Ed-Fi identity Mapping table before sending. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ If the Student Section Association does not exist, the record will go to the Error Log with a message stating: Student (First Name Last Name, Ed-Fi ID) does not have a Student Section Association record for the course (Course Number Course Name). This record must exist before Grades can be sent. • Do not report a record if the any of the following exclusions are present: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Enrollment State Exclude ◦ Enrollment No Show ◦ Enrollment Grade Level Exclude ◦ Calendar Exclude ◦ School Exclude ◦ Course State Exclude ◦ Course State Code is NULL
<p>Delete /Post Put</p>	<p>A DELETE / POST will be performed if the data element being altered is part of the resource's natural key. A PUT will be performed otherwise.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When a grade is updated on a Grading Task or Standard that is mapped to an Ed-Fi Grade Type
<p>Delete</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When the Grading Task or Standard is deleted. • When Grade Type Descriptor is no longer mapped and a resync is performed. • When a Student Section Association no longer exists.
