Post	A Calendars record will be created for each Calendar/Schedule Structure combination				
	<ul> <li>When a new Calendar and Schedule Structure is created and saved via the Calendar Wizard</li> <li>When a new Schedule Structure in an existing Calendar is created and saved</li> <li>Do not send a record if the Calendars resource is toggled 'OFF' in the Calendars Resource Preferences</li> <li>When the Secondary School field is populated, report the student's information from this new school as an override to the current school.</li> </ul>
